Georges Abdallah to be freed after 41 yrs of resistance behind bars



"The French judiciary has officially approved the release of Georges Ibrahim Abdallah, the Lebanese activist and revolutionary who has spent over four decades imprisoned in France, according to statements made Thursday by his legal team.

Abdallah, a prominent figure in leftist resistance circles and a staunch supporter of the Palestinian cause, is set to be released on July 25, his defense lawyer told Al Mayadeen. The decision marks the end of a decades-long legal and political battle over his continued imprisonment.

Al Mayadeen's correspondent in France reported that Georges Abdallah's lawyer has officially informed him of the court's decision granting his release.

Political interference, particularly US, delayed proceedings

Speaking to Al Mayadeen, Abdallah's lawyer confirmed that political interference, particularly from the United States, had delayed the legal proceedings that should have led to his release much earlier.

"The United States exerted pressure to obstruct the legal process leading to his release," he stated, framing the case as a political decision rather than a judicial one. The lawyer also conveyed his congratulations to Abdallah's family.

Abdallah has refused to pay any form of compensation as a condition of his release, reinforcing his longstanding stance against conceding to demands he considers politically motivated.

The Lebanese embassy in Paris is set to handle the official procedures to facilitate the transfer of Georges Ibrahim Abdallah to the airport ahead of his return to Lebanon, according to Al Mayadeen's correspondent in the French capital.

Abdallah to return to Beirut after release

Abdallah will be returning to Beirut following his scheduled release later this month, his defense team confirmed. His brother, Robert Abdallah, emphasized that the delay in Georges' release was due to sustained political pressure. "The obstruction of his release was the result of political pressure from the United States on France," he said.

Abdallah, 74, has long been eligible for release under French law. In November, an enforcement court ruled in favor of his release, concluding that he "no longer poses a serious threat if released." However, the decision was frozen following an appeal by France's national anti-terrorism prosecutor, delaying what supporters say is long-overdue justice.

The case of Georges Abdallah is one of the most politically charged detention cases in modern French history. Originally arrested in 1984 and sentenced to life in 1987, he has been eligible for parole since 1999. Despite repeated legal victories and the support of international human rights organizations, successive French governments, under pressure from Washington and "Tel Aviv", have refused to sign off on his release." english.almayadeen.net

Georges Abdallah back in Lebanon after 40 years in French jail



"One of France's longest-held inmates, the pro-Palestinian Lebanese militant Georges Ibrahim Abdallah, arrived in Beirut on Friday, having been released from prison after more than 40 years behind bars for the alleged killings of two diplomats. At around 3:40 am (0140 GMT), a convoy of six vehicles with flashing lights left the Lannemezan prison in southwest France, AFP journalists saw. Hours later, the 74-year-old was placed on a plane and deported back to Lebanon, to be welcomed by family members on his return to Beirut at the airport's VIP lounge. Dozens of supporters, some waving

Palestinian or Lebanese Communist Party flags, gathered near the arrivals hall to give him a hero's reception, an AFP correspondent said. He later received another hero's welcome by Hezbollah demonstrators on the airport

road, where he got out of the car to salute them. In his first public address after being released, Abdallah took aim at Israel's ongoing war in the Gaza Strip, where human rights organizations have warned of mass starvation. "The children of Palestine are dying of hunger while millions of Arabs watch," he said.

"Resistance must continue and intensify," added the former schoolteacher..." For full article see:

"June 17th is both the birthday of the Love of my Life and the day i became Mrs Sekou Odinga. Sekou always teased me about choosing not to use his name. my response to him was always - like him, i like my name.

its now been 1 1/2 years since Sekou's Transition. And while time does indeed fly right on by, for me those days and months leading up to his departure still feels like yesterday.

i remember all the support he and i got from his comrades and our Movement Family in our time of need. i remember the many interactions we had with hospital staff, physical therapists and community during his 4 1/2 month hospitalization. i remember more than i would like the many ambulance rides, ER visits, ICU stays, tests after tests, the poking and prodding he endured, the medical equipment, doctors and nurses that filled the room the morning he agreed to go on the ventilator cause i asked him to. and i remember him biting the breathing tube, shaking his head no and fighting against all of it when he woke from the induced coma he was placed in so his body could get a much needed rest against the infection raging throughout and debilitating him.

i also remember those last 1 1/2 days of his slowly disappearing breathe after he was taken off the machine that was breathing for him and the many folk who gathered around his bedside to say their goodbyes. i will remember and cherish all the support we got from his comrades and our Movement Family just as i remember but would like to forget the hostility, chaos and disrespect a few folk brought into the mix during those last days. i remember all the bits and pieces of those days so very clearly for they are embedded within my Spirit and memory with a mix of Love, sorrow and appreciation.

i miss Sekou everyday. i think of, laugh and talk to him daily just as i Pray to Allah for the expansion of his grave and he grant me patience over my loss. i continue to yearn for and cry fi continue to yearn for and cry for the moments and days forever lost to me/us, and am comforted that the sound of my cries are no longer as inconsolable or guttural as they once were. i no longer want to scream. i simply want to remember and hold onto the Love we shared.

i am now at a space where i recite the words of this poem a little less:

"loving the gone" by sara rian

i was dragged into a new chapter that day. one that started when your life ended i grabbed at the precious pages but life ripped them away. new chapters have come and many of them good. but i still find myself wanting to go back. to stay with you. bookmarked in the part of my life where you are still living.

and this poem a little more:

"wild hope" -Donna Ashworth so here i am greeting the robins you send me counting the feathers you drop and the rainbows you draw realising there is a new chapter of us we are not done its different but it is something and until we meet again i will make it enough.

and i am learning to accept and embrace these words:

"when we lose someone we love we must not learn to live without them but to live with the love they left behind."

i don't remember who sent these poems/words to me, and i wish that i could tell them how deeply their offerings have spoken to me.

i am deeply grateful for the help of many who have helped me discover ways to ease into and accept this new life and find some measure of peace that my Love is at peace with Allah granting all his afterthis-life Prayers.

and so on this Anniversary of his birth and our marriage, i am remembering Sekou, our lives and Love together!!!

Today, at least 650 prisons across 46 states use incarcerated labor for agricultural production, with over 30,000 incarcerated people working on farms or in food-related positions. 



Mahmoud Khalil seeks damages for irreparable harm from the Trump Administration



"Last week, Mahmoud Khalil filed a claim detailing the harm he has suffered as a result of his politically motivated arrest and detention. The claim is a precursor to a federal lawsuit against the Trump administration, which he will bring under the Federal Tort Claims Act, a 1946 federal statute that allows individuals to sue the U.S. government for damages for civil law violations.

Mr. Khalil is seeking \$20 million, which he would use to help others similarly targeted by the Trump administration and Columbia University. He would accept, in lieu of payment, an official apology and

Yafeu Iyapo - Rest in peace and power

"It is with heavy hearts that we share the passing of our beloved, Yafeu Iyapo, also known as Leonard Alexander, who transitioned on the morning of June 24, 2025, due to complications following surgery for a brain tumor. Yafeu was incarcerated for over 50 years—since April 22, 1975. Over the course of his incarceration, Yafeu endured 33 years in solitary confinement, primarily at Pelican Bay. He stood firmly for justice and human dignity, participating in three Pelican Bay hunger strikes demanding basic human rights. During the 33 years in solitary confinement, he was never eligible to go before the Board of Parole to advocate for his freedom. After over three decades of struggle and perseverance, he was granted parole twice, most recently on June 6, 2025. He was serving his last 3 months of the mandatory waiting period before release, and tragically, he never had the chance to walk free. We are raising funds to support funeral arrangements and a celebration of life, and to assist Makini as she navigates this profound loss and enters a new chapter. 

"The revolutionary, grassroots National Jericho Movement works for recognition that Political Prisoners and Prisoners of War exist inside the United States. Jericho organizes for amnesty, medical care, legal representation, and freedom for all Political Prisoners, our freedom fighters. The Jericho Movement originated with the official Jericho Movement March on the White House in 1998, co-sponsored by the Provisional Government of the Republic of New Afrika (PGRNA) and the New Afrikan Liberation Front (NALF). Jalil Muntaqim, a veteran Black Liberation Army Political Prisoner/POW for 27 years (out after 49 years in 2020!), proposed the march, borrowing from the PGRNA, which led marches to free Political Prisoners in front

of the White House from the mid 1980s through 1993. Jalil organized, from prison, with former Political Prisoners Safiya Bukhari and Herman Ferguson to launch the Jericho Movement. Committees were then formed for Political Prisoners – to build their freedom and amnesty campaigns, educate communities across the country on their existence, provide legal defense funding, and fight for sufficient and quality medical care in prison..." 

In 2016, Jessica took a stand against the construction of the Dakota Access Pipeline. Jessica and her fellow organizers attended public comment hearings, gathered signatures for valid requests for Environmental Impact Statements, and participated in civil disobedience, hunger strikes, marches and rallies, boycotts and encampments.

In 2017, Jessica and another person took direct action and disabled construction machinery in order to protect the land. No one was injured by their actions, and the land was protected from the flow of oil for an additional six months. Jessica has worked with the Catholic Worker and the homeless populations of Duluth and Des Moines. THE FARC "The imprisonment of Ricardo Palmera is a direct result of U.S. intervention in Colombia's civil war. The FARC formed in 1964 after Colombia's elites and their U.S. allies violently attacked an independent peasants' movement. Ricardo Palmera joined the FARC in 1989 after seeing most of his friends and comrades of the Patriotic Union

political party murdered or exiled. The Colombian Military and their death squads murdered more than 4000 candidates, members, and elected officials of the Patriotic Union. Today, the FARC is a rebel army of 28,000 fighting for national liberation. It consists mainly of peasants and one-third of its fighters are women. However, FARC members come from all walks of life, including leaders like Professor Palmera. The FARC fight for social justice, seeking democratic social and economic change, organizing the poor to overthrow the rich and become the rulers of society. The FARC opposes the U.S. Empire -- where U.S. corporations steal the oil, coal, minerals, gems, and agricultural products that belong to the Colombian people. The FARC appeals to the American people to demand peace, not war, from Bush and other leaders.

We demand the U.S. release Simon Trinidad

Ricardo Palmera, popularly known as Simon Trinidad in Colombia, is a political prisoner of the U.S. government. Simon Trinidad is being tortured in solitary confinement in the Florence, Colorado supermax prison. Trinidad beat the U.S. government in three out of four court trials. Trinidad is held in solitary confinement violating his human rights. Trinidad is held as a political prisoner by the U.S. government under Special Administrative Measures (SAMS), meaning his rights are more restricted than other prisoners. 



"On December 9, 1981 Mumia Abu-Jamal, a journalist and former Black Panther, was arrested for the murder of a white Philadelphia police officer Daniel Faulkner. He was convicted and sentenced to death in a trial that was rife with perjured testimony and manufactured evidence that Amnesty International found, "did not meet the minimum international standards for a fair trial."

Mumia was working as a cab driver to make extra money when he happened upon Officer Faulkner, who had stopped his brother Billy Cook, and was beating him in the head with a metal flashlight. The prosecutor, Joseph McGill, presented a story that has Mumia running behind the officer and shooting him in the back. He then claimed that the officer turned around and pulled his weapon, shooting Mumia in the chest. McGill ends the story by saying the officer fell to the ground, where Mumia stood over him and unloaded on him, missing with four shots but hitting him once between the eyes. McGill also claimed that Mumia confessed to the shooting later on in police custody.

None of the physical evidence supports the prosecution's case! Mumia did legally own a gun, not uncommon for anyone driving a cab in Philadelphia during that time. However, the police never tested his gun to see if it had been fired nor tested his hands to see if they had recently fired a gun. They bullet taken from Faulkner could not be matched to Mumia's gun..." For full article see:

Emergency Medical Campaign for Kojo Bomani Sababu (Grailing Brown)

"We received the below email from Kojo this morning, July 12, 2025:

"I am sick as I write you. I cannot explain what the problem is. That is why I seek your assistance to ascertain what is happening. System of problem unknown, however my head is spinning several times daily. I complained and an x-ray of my brain was taken. I had injections of something provided by medical. Now I am going through

the situation once again. I feel faint and dizzy currently. I am reaching out. This is something I need the comrades to do. Build To Win! Kojo"

We are asking people to email, fax and call Butner FMC to inquire as to why they are not giving this serious medical situation the attention required to ascertain what exactly is causing this alarming problem. You can request to speak with his counselor. If that is not possible, please state your concern regarding this recurring medical problem. Be polite but firm in demanding that proper medical attention be provided to Kojo. Kojo is 72 years old and has been in prison since 1975. He was originally transferred to Butner for a hip replacement, which was successful. Now we need to support our elder and ensure he gets the medical attention he needs. URGENT CALL TO ACTION: Support Kevin Rashid Johnson Today: Medical Care Needed Now!

"Longtime Prison Radio correspondent and Red Onion whistleblower Kevin "Rashid" Johnson has just spent months in solitary confinement and was moved a few days ago into the general population of South Carolina's Perry Correctional Institute. When We Fight, We Win, and this release from the hole is a result of Rashid's unwavering commitment to exposing injustices from the inside and the unrelenting calls and emails from his supporters demanding his release from solitary. In May, Rashid was violently transferred to South Carolina in an attempt to silence his reporting. This transfer can only be seen as punishment for speaking up about the unconstitutional abuses taking place at Red Onion State Prison. While being held he was denied outside communication, legal mail, and basic medical care. Those in South Carolina prisons can be held in solitary 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The methods by which SC practices solitary confinement are officially classified as torture under international law by the United Nations.

Rashid recently detailed the abuse that those in solitary at Perry are experiencing:

They are confined to small, cold cells where bugs, spiders, and mice crawl over them.

They are not allowed outside, there is no view of outside the cell, and no fresh air.

They are not allowed any personal property or books to read.

The food is disgusting and the portions are insufficient, everyone complains about hunger pains.

On the weekends they often go 20 hours in between dinner and breakfast.

Prisoners are routinely gassed and beaten by guards, sometimes they're hogtied and left naked in empty cells for hours on end.

Withholding food, medications, and showers is a common form of punishment and control.

Rashid Still Needs Medical Attention:

After weeks of Rashid and his supporters demanding he receive medical care, the prison dentist gave him an x-ray which confirmed he has an abscess in one tooth and another tooth that is broken. If untreated, the infection can spread to other parts of the body and cause sepsis and necrotizing fasciitis, which can lead to death. After still being denied proper medical treatment, Rashid resorted to lancing and draining the abscess on his own, using soap and water. His first attempt was unsuccessful and has resulted in major swelling of his lip and face. He plans to try again using salt water now that he is back in the general population.







Leonard Peltier would like to be a spokesman for his people. Leonard has spent 50 years with his head up, facing a storm of racism and oppression. He has not flinched. He has not bent. They tried to break his spirit – it grew stronger. A tree that is battered by the wind grows strong.

He has an unparalleled grasp of what tyranny and oppression truly look like.

The Bureau of Prisons has severely curtailed Leonard's speech. We are trying to determine whether he is allowed to speak about not being able to speak about the things he is not allowed to speak about. If you find that confusing, consider applying it to the words that come out of your mouth.

Leonard says he has an awesome new cell, but it is still a cell. He can breathe free air and lie in the sun. That is everything, but until Leonard is irrevocably free, the work will go on.

Leonard Peltier's supporters have been coming through magnificently with donations.

Freedom isn't free, especially for someone who has endured 50 years of medical neglect.

There is a mythology around Indigenous people on reservations "being taken care of" by the government. Indian Health Service tries, but they are limited by a budget. They can only handle one issue at a time, and Leonard has several health problems, all of which are urgent.

Leonard still has infected teeth. When they are removed and he's ready for dentures, the typical wait is three months for the gums to heal. I've been told some people have waited over a year.

Leonard Peltier will not go a year with no teeth. In prison, he had not seen a dentist in over ten years. We are done with Leonard doing without. We will go outside the system and get him fitted with temporary dentures.

Because of you, we can tell Leonard that we are able to **schedule** a **dental appointment** as **needed**. We can pay for temporary dentures and also cover the cost of relining them when necessary. When he is ready for permanent dentures, they will fit well because of you. We are incredibly grateful to each and every one of you. Leonard is 80 years old, but he is a young 80. With decent ongoing healthcare, he has many years ahead of him to be a spokesman for his people, to enjoy the simple life that he has been denied for so long. www.freeleonardpeltiernow.org/donate #LeonardPeltierFreed #JusticeDelayedJusticeDenied." Calls For Action

Tell Congress: No War on Iran & No Arms for Israel June 18



"As people who have tirelessly demanded an end to Israel's genocidal assault on Gaza, we now face another critical and urgent front in our struggle. Israel's recent large-scale airstrikes inside Iran have brought the region to the edge of a full-blown war. Iran has already begun retaliating. The risk of widespread, devastating conflict is real and rising by the hour. President Trump is barreling toward another illegal and catastrophic U.S. military entanglement. But we still have a chance to stop it. A bipartisan group in Congress is demanding that Trump seek authorization under the War Powers Act before taking any military action against Iran. Among the leaders of this push are Senator Tim Kaine and Representatives Ro Khanna and Thomas Massie. Their efforts could be the difference between diplomacy and disaster.

This all comes as Israel's genocide in Gaza continues. This morning, Israeli forces killed at least 70 Palestinians and wounded over 300 in Khan Younis as they gathered for aid. Nearly 400 have died in similar incidents since the U.S.- and Israeli-backed distribution system began in late May. At the root of this crisis is the same

unchecked militarism we've been fighting: Israel's apartheid regime and its campaign of destruction, from Gaza to Tehran. U.S. weapons and unconditional support have enabled this violence for far too long. It must end. Take Action Now: Email your members of Congress and demand they sign onto Sen. Kaine's and Rep. Massie's resolutions.

Drop the "conspiracy" charges against LA anti-ICE protester Alejandro Orellana!

"On the morning of June 12, the FBI, accompanied by the National Guard and LA sheriffs, raided the home of Alejandro Orellana for his protesting of ICE raids in Los Angeles. He was arrested, taken into federal custody, then released the next day - after much public pressure and many phone calls to the U.S. Attorney.

Now he faces two bogus federal charges: one for conspiracy to commit civil disorder and another for aiding and abetting civil disorder. He is facing serious prison time.

Alejandro Orellana is a longtime activist in LA's Chicano community. When immigrant rights are under attack he helps organize the protests. When law enforcement guns down people in the Boyle Heights neighborhood, Orellana is one of the speakers on the bullhorn demanding justice. He is a Teamster, who is an activist on the shop floor. As a former marine, he is opposed to unjust U.S. wars abroad.

In Los Angeles, ICE agents, the National Guard, Department of Homeland Security agents, and U.S. troops are roaming the streets. Wearing masks to hide their identities, they abduct undocumented people, tearing apart families in the process. The people of LA have a right to protest. Standing up to ICE is not a crime. The charges against Alejandro Orellana should be dropped. Now!

The Committee to Stop FBI Repression has called for a National Day of Action on June 27, the date of Orellana's preliminary hearing. We are calling on all those who value civil liberties to hold actions on that day. We are calling on all supporters of Orellana to call U.S. Attorney Essayli at 213-894-2400 on June 27 as well.

The U.S attorney claims that Orellana drove a pickup truck carrying PPE (personal protective equipment) including face shields, and that this is their basis for arresting and charging him. In our view, there's nothing wrong with looking out for people's safety. Police often shoot rubber bullets, as a result there are multiple cases of protesters losing eyes. Helping to prevent this is a good thing.

The California Central District U.S. Attorney Bilal Essayli who filed the charges against Orellana was appointed by U.S. Attorney General Pam Bondi, a dedicated Trump supporter who helped build his MAGA think tank. He is Trump's man in California.

Essayli has pursued charges against other anti-ICE protesters, such as David Huerta, the president of the Service Employees International Union California, who was held on a \$50,000 bail. Essayli is the legal representative of the Trump administration in the court battle over who controls California's National Guard. In his time as a California state legislator, Essayli authored bills targeting parents of trans kids and criminalizing the teaching of "critical race theory." He has revealed himself to be an all-around opponent of democratic rights and anything progressive

The Trump administration and its tools such as U.S. Attorney Essayli are out to crush any dissent of Trump's immigration policy. They seek to trample the First Amendment rights of protesters in order to do it. Orellana's activism is the real reason he is in the FBI and prosecutors' sights. An attack on Orellana is an attack on anyone who cherishes the right to resist mass deportations and the many other wrongdoings of the Trump administration. Maggots in food, overflowing toilets, and 32 people per cage: Welcome to 'Alligator Alcatraz'



'Alligator Alcatraz' Is the Newest Site of Human Rights Abuses Against Immigrants. Demand Its Closure, Now! Surrounded by snakes and alligators in a swelteringly hot swamp, approximately 900 people have been crammed into a hastily-constructed camp of plastic tents and metal cages in the middle of the Florida Everglades. In only 8 days, authorities set up a camp that currently can hold around 3,000 humans — and with

the intention of housing even more in the upcoming weeks and months. While Trump and his cronies laugh about having created 'Alligator Alcatraz,' very real human beings have been shoved into facilities with maggots in their sparse food, intense overheating, and so few showers, people have to wake up at 3am to get the chance to bathe — or risk going another week without being clean. The camp's tents each have multiple cages, with 32 humans locked in per cage. Each cage has 3 open-air toilet-sink combination units, in which the drinking water emerges from a faucet on the back of the toilet's tank. There is no privacy or shielding. To drink water, you must first wait for one of the other 32 individuals to finish using the toilet. Even worse: many of the toilets won't flush, leading to serious sanitation issues. And that's just what we actually know. Because Florida and ICE have been trying to prevent lawmakers from learning more. First, they blocked members of Congress from touring the facilities at all. Then, once lawmakers filed a lawsuit, authorities finally allowed them in — but only into the sections that are currently empty and awaiting more bodies to fill them. Lawmakers weren't even allowed to see the so-called "medical" section at all. This is not justice. This is not humane. This is inconceivable and morally unjustifiable. We must not sit quietly while this situation escalates. Sign the petition to demand the U.S. federal government and Florida governments shut down Alligator Alcatraz immediately!" Source: Email.

Lakota Law executive director Chase Iron Eyes and I have been working on a number of cases, and today I'll focus with you on one specific effort. I believe it to be particularly important, because it's about fairness and can protect some of the most vulnerable people in Colorado's Indigenous community.

In coordination with a few allied groups, we recently sent a <u>letter and a set of powerful testimonials</u> to Colo. Gov. Jared Polis. We hope he'll lend his assistance to provide access to constitutionally- and state law-guaranteed religious practice for incarcerated Indigenous People in Colorado. Abortion rights political prisoner resisting federal grand jury (Please write)



"New Political Prisoner recognized by the ABCF

Hridindu Roychowdhury is an anarchist from Madison, Wisconcin who was sentenced to 90 months in federal prison for attacking a building with a Molotov cocktail in the wake of the leak of the draft opinion in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization, overruling Roe v. Wade.

He targeted the building because it was occupied by an anti-choice organization (Wisconsin Family Action). Roychowdhury acknowledged spray-painting the message "If abortions aren't safe then you aren't either" on the outside of the building. No one was in the office at the time. Roychowdhury pleaded guilty on Dec. 1, 2023. He was was ordered to pay nearly \$32,000 in restitution and was

serving his sentence at FCI Marion. He received a 7.5 year sentence.

In May 2005, he was shipped to Wisconsin to go before a grand jury. Hridindu is currently being held in federal civil contempt of court for refusing to cooperate/snitch at a federal grand jury proceeding. After the judge recently found him in contempt for refusing to answer questions within the grand jury room, he sits in this county jail without earning any good time—in essence his federal time is frozen until contempt is purged. He is currently housed in a county jail in Wisconsin after being transferred there from the federal prison he was assigned after he took a non-cooperation plea deal and was sentenced. Hridindu is currently being held in federal civil contempt of court for refusing to cooperate/snitch at a federal grand jury proceeding. After the judge recently found him in contempt for refusing to answer questions within the grand jury room, he sits in this county jail without earning any good time—in essence his federal time is frozen until contempt is purged. Originally from the U.S. Southwest, he is a diligent academic and enjoyer of word puzzles and Terry Pratchett novels. Earlier in federal detention, he had been keeping himself busy by taking courses in advanced mathematics, tutoring other people in prison to complete their GED tests, and participating with a dog training program. He was moved to county jail in 2025 in retaliation for refusing to cooperate with a federal grand jury. Mailing instructions:

We Condemn the FBI Seizure of Phone of Immigrants Rights Activist Verita Topete! Drop the Charges on Alejandro Orellana, Stop the FBI Witch Hunt!



"On June 26, FBI stalked and ambushed CSO member Verita Topete while she was alone, walking her dog at Ernest E Debs Park. They served her with a warrant and seized her phone. They are on a witch hunt and seek to criminalize people who organize for immigrants rights and speak out against deportations, ICE, and Trump. They temporarily detained her before releasing her.

The Committee to Stop FBI Repression sees this as an act of political repression against the immigrants rights movement, as well as Chicanos and Latinos. Topete co-leads the Immigration Committee of Centro CSO.

Two weeks ago, another member of Centro CSO was raided and arrested into federal custody by the FBI, Alejandro Orellana. He has also been outspoken against the ICE raids that have brought terror upon immigrants across southern California. He, like Topete, has been at the forefront of the movement, leading and attending protests. He was held in federal custody for a day as supporters called into the US attorney Bilal Essayli's office – notable Trump defender in the state of California – to demand his release. Though Orellana was released, he now faces two bogus federal charges, one for conspiracy to commit civil disorder and one for aiding and abetting civil disorder. At least one of those carries up to 5 years in prison.

Those who support civil liberties and the First Amendment right to free speech should view these cases for what they are: an FBI witch hunt, and an attempt to squash political dissent against Trump. Protesting is not a crime, and speaking up to demand an end to ICE raids is not a crime. Neither Verita Topete nor Alejandro Orellana have done anything wrong.

Anyone who is serious about protecting the right to criticize the US government, and in this case Donald Trump and his administration, should demand that the charges on Alejandro Orellano be dropped. We demand that Verita Topete's phone is returned to her at once and that the FBI witch hunt come to an end immediately. Today, on June 27, we are also asking everyone who supports Alejandro Orellana to call into US attorney Bilal Essayli's office at 213-894-2400 and demand that the charges be dropped.

Drop the Charges on Alejandro Orellana! Justice for Verita Topete! Stop the FBI Witch Hunt! Protesting ICE is Not a Crime! In addition to the national call-in, at least 16 cities will be rallying at federal courthouses to demand the dropping of the charges on Alejandro Orellana. We are an ad hoc group of Pacifica Radio program producers and other community media advocates who have been meeting since January via Zoom to define a strategy and structure to take on the attacks on press freedom

and political expression by the Trump Administration and its allies. They have targeted media platforms where liberal, progressive, and anti-racist voices share information (newspapers, radio, television, college, and the growing prison press). We're also outraged by the life-threatening attacks in this country on political speech denouncing the genocide of Palestinians. That includes the arrests and deportations of people exercising political speech, both among immigrants and citizens. There's also been an alarming increase in physical attacks against journalists, including killings, most egregiously and in large numbers in Gaza, and also through the use of "non-lethal" but actually injury-producing projectiles in the recent L.A. protests against ICE, used against journalists and activists alike. These are examples of the types of repression we will speak out against. Our tentative draft Statement of Purpose is here. We take our name from Ida B. Wells, the fearless Black journalist and anti-lynching crusader who exposed the machinery of white supremacy with unflinching truth. We are working on a public Pledge of Resistance to defend dissent, resist censorship, and build a culture of solidarity, truth-telling, and protection for those who use media as a tool for justice. More to come.... Our next public activity after this week's introduction will be a hybrid in-person and Zoom teach-in/forum some time in August to provide education about these issues and help build the Rapid Response Network and the Pledge of Resistance for press freedom and freedom of political expression for those advocating for justice. So please join us this Friday. We welcome your input and ideas, and any way you can step forward to share your skills, whether you have time to consistently attend meetings or not. 

The Life of Queer Black Panther Ericka Huggins; & The Book of Everyday Resistance July 22

Black Panther Woman: The Political and Spiritual Life of Ericka Huggins"

"In this segment, we'll be discussing the first biography published on one of Out-FM's repeated guests: revered Black Panther and queer Ericka Huggins who is also a mother, widow, educator, poet, and former political prisoner, held for two years. She is also the coauthor, with Stephen Shames, of the 2022 book, *Comrade Sisters: Women of the Black Panther Party*.

The new biography was written by Dr. Mary Frances Phillips, Associate Professor of African American Studies at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign and cocreator of the <u>Intersectional Black Panther Party History Project</u>. Dr. Phillips is our guest for this two-part interview, joining us from Illinois. Rhonda Williams, author

of Concrete Demands: The Search for Black Power in the 20th Century, has written a comment about Dr. Phillips's new book, titled Black Panther Woman: The Political and Spiritual Life of Ericka Huggins: "A remarkable story of awakening, commitment, grit, and fearlessness in the wake of personal pain, grassroots struggle, and state violence. [It] is itself a meditation on the pertinence and power of spiritual wellness and encourages us to consider what a radically holistic movement for liberation might need."

In Part 1 of the interview, Out-FM's Stahimili Mapp and Bob Lederer discuss with Mary Phillips her attempt to disrupt "the skewed public image of female revolutionaries as silenced helpmates and background characters,

placing a necessary spotlight on Huggins transformative self-care practices, feminist theories, and educational activist work." They also discuss how Ericka and other incarcerated women resisted being crushed by brutal treatment in prison "by protecting, caring for, and uplifting one another when faced with brutality, and the torture of solitary confinement in particular." They also discuss how they responded using direct action hunger strikes "to protest the lack of prenatal and postnatal care for pregnant women, as well as the substandard nutrition and horrific prison conditions." In addition, we will play a clip from our 2020 interview with Ericka Huggins. Tune in a week from now, Tues., July 29 at 8PM ET, for Part 2 of this interview, including another clip from Ericka and from political prisoner and former Panther Mumia Abu-Jamal in praise of Ericka's work. What is the film about?

Sharing footage of Nation Territory and highlighting voices of Tonawanda Seneca citizens, this film documents the Tonawanda Seneca Nation's existential fight to stop the Western NY Science and Technology Advanced Manufacturing Park (STAMP), a proposed mega-industrial site currently being constructed on the border of the Nation's present-day reservation territory in Western NY. STAMP would irreparably harm lands and waters where Tonawanda Seneca citizens continue to hunt, fish, and gather traditional medicines, and thus constitutes an existential threat to the Nation's collective continuance on their homelands.

Where is the Nation in their fight against STAMP?

The Nation, a federally recognized Indigenous Nation and part of the Hadeunosaunee, has opposed the construction of STAMP on the border of its current Reservation Territory in WNY since it was first proposed nearly 20 years ago, yet the project continues to be underwritten by NYS funding and facilitated by permitting by NYS agencies. The Tonawanda Seneca Nation Council of Chiefs views STAMP as cultural genocide. Today, the Nation is fighting to Rethink STAMP in solidarity with local residents and a growing coalition of allied individuals and organizations across New York state and beyond.

How Can Allies Take Action?

For years, NY Renews has followed the leadership of the Nation in its efforts against STAMP because we uphold that Indigenous Sovereignty is climate justice, and that the proposed projects at STAMP, from "green" hydrogen production to massive data centers, threaten our climate law.







DID YOU KNOW that in 2021, the U.S was found GUILTY of five accounts of genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous people??

Dear Friend and Fellow Freedom Fighter,

The Spirit of Mandela Coalition, following up on the October 2021 International Tribunal verdict finding the US Guilty of Genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous people (see full verdict HERE), is calling for the building of a new mass grassroots formation: The Peoples' Senate. The people need to govern and represent themselves in combating genocide and addressing their right to a just and humane existence. Our vision is for the Peoples' Senate, organized directly by our oppressed communities, to grow into a body which will serve that purpose.

Today our communities face the most egregious violations of our human rights since the civil rights and Black power movements of the 1960s and '70s. Conditions we are living under include random mass shootings, rightwing vigilante attacks, police violence and murder, environmental racism, the reassertion of "states rights" (the "right" of states to ignore basic human rights), and healthcare racism. The US government dangerously scapegoats immigrants; causes destabilization, extreme violence, bombing, and killing of Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people all over the globe – and spends billions of dollars to do it; and keeps hundreds of thousands of people living in homelessness and poverty in the US. Our communities are facing targeted attacks against voting rights, workers' rights, women's rights, and Indigenous Peoples' rights as right-wing elected officials and appointed judges roll back decades of hard-won battles for justice. While out-voting right-wing candidates during elections is important, voting alone will not be enough. We must organize to put more pressure on the system for major change.

The US Congress and Senate are representatives of the rich and powerful. They refuse to address the necessity for universal healthcare or a sound nationwide infrastructure providing access to clean water and other necessities. Corporations ignore and violate the needs of the planet while evading their fair share of taxes. US prisons are filled with Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people, many incarcerated for crimes they did not commit and/or serving sentences that far outweigh whatever criminal acts they may have committed. The oppressed national communities of Black, Brown, and Indigenous peoples all have political prisoners and prisoners of war incarcerated since the 1960s until today, who have fought for our liberation and are being held in prison unjustly or only released when near death. We want them all freed now!

Building our own Peoples' Senate will enable us to organize locally from a position of strength and connect local activists with others, in other parts of the country, who may be pursuing similar goals while electing "Senators" who are mandated to represent our interests and demands. A Peoples' Senate can fight for changes that protect and ensure our right to vote, our right to control our own bodies, our right to live free from discrimination as LGBTQ+ people, our rights to living wages and safe working conditions, our rights to sovereignty and dignity, and our rights to live free from state violence and abuse.
