We Welcome National Jericho's New Political Prisoners

Stewart, Joseph "Shine White"

Joseph has been incarcerated for 16 years in the North Carolina prison system and is currently captive at Scotland CI in Laurinburg. As a social prisoner and former "street tribe" member, he was politicized in prison through the writings

of revolutionaries like George Jackson. He is also the former National Spokesperson of the White Panther Organization.

Within the last few years, Joseph lost his national support network due to several reasons: (1) his condemnation of Keith Washington as an informant, (2) a split in the New Afrikan Black Panther Party, and (3) his increasing identification with the New Afrikan Independence Movement based on the writings of James Yaki Sayles (because Joseph is white, this is seen as taboo by many). In 2024, Kevin Rashid Johnson wrote about Joseph, [here](#).

Joseph has been at the head of efforts to educate and raise the political consciousness of white prisoners in particular, and to counter the miseducation of whites with reactionary views that divide and play whites and Blacks and other people of color against each other as part of the divide and conquer strategies of the ruling class. He has also raised his voice in opposition against abuses of other prisoners by officials. For more information about Joseph and to read his

Abdul developed the George Jackson University, that at one time had over a million students. "The state" shut it down, of course and he had to rebuild, which he did. A powerful statement of his undaunted spirit and fierce resistance to injustice and illegitimate authority, while enduring the state's torture program of forcing New Afrikans into security housing units (SHUs), solitary confinement, designed to break their revolutionary mind and spirit.

Captured at 16-years-old, Abdul spent the next 44+ years under severely oppressive and repressive conditions, studying, analyzing, developing theories; all which he put into practice to develop his mind, body and spirit and become an educator, an author of multiple educational books and a highly conscious New Afrikan man.

Despite expected violence, human rights violations and denial of his freedom by the state and CDCr, he, along with his New Afrikan Brothas, practiced Black August year after year; participated in the Historic California Hunger Strikes, to which they committed to their death, if necessary. Abdul engaged in the class action lawsuit, *Ashker v Brown*, to end indefinite solitary confinement, demonstrating the ability and need to build unity with outside orgs, activists, etc. to build power and win, and he was the mastermind behind the original concept of the Agreement to End Hostilities – the most important

document of the past 50 years. So powerful, CDCr undermined its implementation into California's prisons, but it couldn't be stopped – wherever it was, violence decreased significantly. Abdul Olugbala Shakur was told the only way to escape the torture of the SHU was to “parole, snitch or die.” He stood firm against all those dehumanizing options to maintain his humanity, follow in the footsteps of his Ancestors and continue to serve the People.”

Remembering Eddie Conway (The Real News Network)



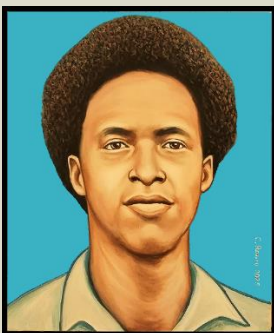
“It has been three years since we lost Brother Eddie Conway. I first met Eddie in 1970, just a few months before he was arrested, railroaded for the murder of a Baltimore City Police officer. (can add, This was during a time in which the Baltimore Panthers office was constantly being raided by police and false arrests were being made) The Black Panthers and White Revolutionaries organizing in poor working class neighborhoods

were in an alliance. So, when they took Eddie, everyone stood together with him.

Eddie was an Army veteran and warrior for the people. He was a stand-up guy to his core. He spent 44 (1970 to 2014) years imprisoned, but in all that time, Eddie never changed. He was known as a peacemaker, an organizer, a counselor, and a teacher. A man respected by all serving time with him, and by a number of the prison guards. He was a revolutionary before he went in, during his incarceration, and until he drew his last breath. The movement stood with him during his incarceration and we were all there on the day he was set free! Then, TRNN came to Eddie and he became one of the heartbeats of this organization.

Eddie’s life was dedicated to justice, to building a world that was just and equitable for all. To fighting to change the racist society that unjustly stole his freedom. Eddie was dedicated to the woman who stood by him through it all, and to his children. We were lucky here at TRNN to have his guiding light, his wisdom, his strength. Thank You, Eddie! SALUTE TO A TRUE BLACK PANTHER, JAMAL JOSEPH



“I had a wonderful time on Saturday afternoon when I visited the New Heritage Theatre Group in Harlem, New York City. This mesmerizing facility caters to the propagation and preservation of Black arts and culture. My intention in going there was to meet up with an old friend and comrade, Jamal Joseph, who happens to serve on the board of this group. I went there specifically to bring him a special gift of affection and respect, a 20” X 24” acrylic canvas portrait I made of his image during his youth.

I met Jamal when we were both 17 years old in 1971. Jamal was a Black Panther, and I was a Young Lord. One day on that year, I was assigned to deliver to the Black Panther Party office in Harlem a ream of flyers announcing a demonstration the Young Lords called for in East Harlem.

In 1969, Jamal was among a group of Panthers arrested by the NYPD as part of a COINTELPRO operation aimed at destroying the BPP. The arrestees became known as the *Panther 21*. They were eventually released after the legendary people's lawyer William Kunstler proved in court their innocence and the government's malicious intent.

After the most unfortunate split in the BPP Jamal became part of the Black Liberation Army (BLA) for which he served over five years in Fort Leavenworth Prison.

Today, long after many years experiencing ordeals as a political prisoner, Joseph challenges the racist stigma against Black people and Black cultural forms by being the founder and director of IMPACT Repertory Theatre, a performance group comprised of Black and Brown youth based in Harlem.

He is also a poet, author, educator and activist. Jamal continues to proudly uphold the legacy of the Black liberation struggle by sharing knowledge of Black history and culture through his work in the arts. A common belief that Jamal shares with yours truly is that in the liberation struggle art and culture have the potential of becoming weapons against oppressors in the battle of ideas.

De Facto World War: Hegemonic Religious Warfare of the 21st Century

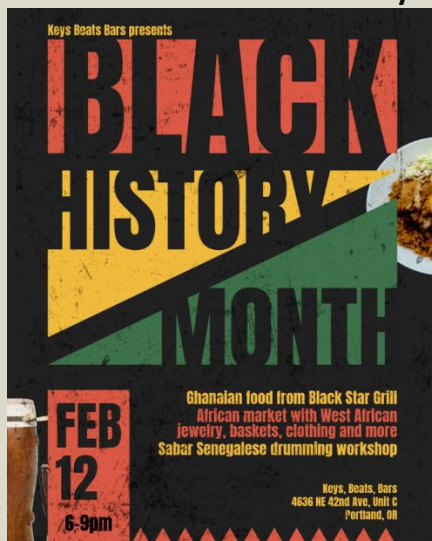

Honoring Lives Taken by ICE | LIVE in Minnesota

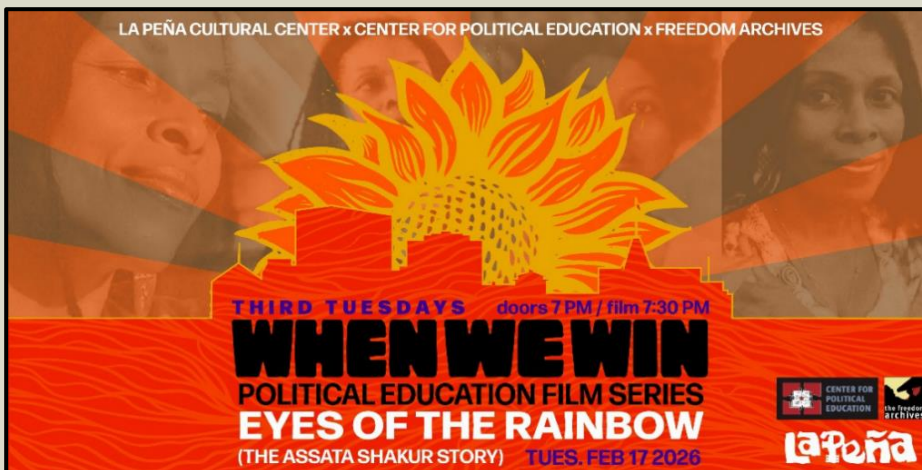


"We're LIVE at the Renée Good public memorial and ceremony to honor and mourn the lives taken by ICE, Border Patrol, and DHS in the past 25 years. **Wokiksuye** means in Remembrance and Witness in Lakota – please join First Peoples of Mni Sóta Makoce for an official public memorial ceremony in collaboration with the Good family. We ask that you continue to uplift community-led solutions and the good work being done across Turtle Island to keep

each other safe. Including but not limited to plugging into a Tribal ID card registration event, hosting a Know Your Rights ICE training, providing grocery delivery to impacted families, taking part in ICE patrols in your community, and raising donations for gas/food cards for those holding the line. ICE has locked up **3,800 children in ICE concentration camps** since 2025. Lives are being taken within detention, including Mariee Juares (18 mo), Wilme Ramirez (2 yrs), Anadith Reyes (8 yrs), and Darlyn Cristabel (10 yrs). Children do not belong in government detention camps and are meant to be safe with their families. We ask you to please keep the families, children, and communities directly impacted by this ICE occupation in your prayers. **Join the live** to listen to statements provided by the Good family, local community leaders, organizers, poets, artists, and more! “We are Jalil Muntaqim and Ashaki Binta, National Co-Coordinator of the National Mobilization Against Genocides, July 4th 2026, in Atlanta, Georgia’s WEST END PARK. We are introducing you to this national mobilization because it is believed you and/or your organization fully understand the nature of the genocidal attack Black, Brown and Indigenous people have suffered in this corporate entity called the United States of America. At no time during the 500 years of Indigenous genocide, Afrikan enslavement, and LatinX colonialism/occupation have people not suffered and fought to obtain every civil and human right afforded us by virtue of our resistance to white supremacy and capitalist super-exploitation.

On July 4th, 2026, this now racist-fascist government will be celebrating 250 years of their "independence" - really racial-genocide and exploitation in negation of our struggle and resistance. They will seek to consolidate and strengthen their Project 2025 agenda of erasure and denial of Black, Brown and Indigenous peoples, and their promotion of white-christian nationalism and fascism. We, and our histories of resistance, will not be celebrated at their July 4th, 2026 events!!! Let us be certain of that reality!!!

Subject to the findings and decision by the 2021 International Tribunal on Genocide, (<https://www.youtube.com/watch>) the esteemed body of International Jurists declared that the United States government has been engaged in the practice of genocide against Black, Brown and Indigenous peoples. The Spirit of Mandela Coalition (www.spiritofmandela.org) has therefore decided to remove ourselves from future harm and genocidal trauma. As part of this development of securing our lives against the continued onslaught of the white-christian nationalist Project 2025 agenda, we are organizing the National Mobilization Against Genocides, July 4th, 2026, in Atlanta, Georgia to celebrate our 250+ years of resistance against white supremacy and genocide.

In this regard, Jihad Abdulmumit, Chair of the Spirit of Mandela Coalition, has forwarded this proposed platform for the National Mobilization Against Genocides, which we are introducing to you for your active participation and support:

Today’s reading of the United States Declaration of Independence leaves little to celebrate. The forefathers of the USA called to dissolve the political bonds that connected their new colonies to the British empire. However, the masses of people living here, created equal in the eyes of God/Allah/the Great Spirit, were in no way treated equally or free by those who proclaimed this land to be the “United States.” The truth is this country had replaced the British empire with another even more genocidal one.

Although many "Americans" on July 4th, 2026, will wave flags and celebrate “bombs bursting in air” for the 250th anniversary of the USA’s Declaration of Independence, for many others, the relevance of

the Declaration will be centered on a critique of tyrannical leaders and a government celebrating 250 years of genocidal policies and practices. The Spirit of Mandela Coalition, continuing the work of the 2021 International Tribunal that found the US government GUILTY OF GENOCIDE against Black, Brown, and Indigenous Peoples, (spiritofmandela.org), will commemorate 250+ years of consistent resistance. We will celebrate the building of new people's movements, united fronts, international alliances, and local initiatives fiercely combatting modern genocide, imperialism, white supremacist oppression, and injustice.

The 19th Century Abolitionist Frederick Douglass asked, "What to the Slave on the Fourth of July?" (MassHumanities.org). In the legacy of Crazy Horse, Rev. 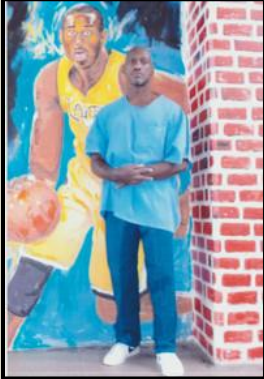

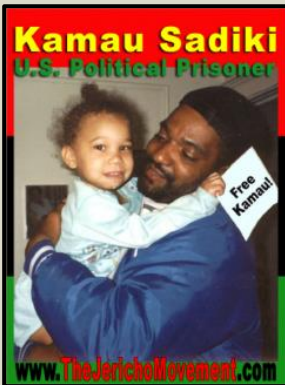

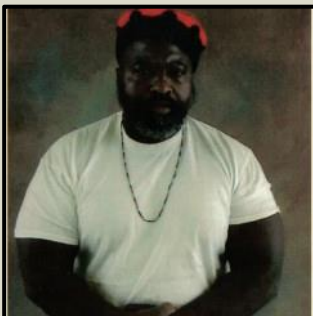

Kamau Sadiki is a father, grandfather, and Political Prisoner. He is also a veteran of the Black Panther Party, wrongfully convicted when the FBI, in their efforts to recapture Assata Shakur, convinced Atlanta police to reopen a 30-year-old cold case murder of a Fulton County police officer, and charge Mr.

Sadiki. The police told Kamau that if he worked with them and "got Assata to leave Cuba" and go to some other country where they could apprehend her, they would not prosecute on the false police killing charge. The police offer was rejected, and Kamau, now serving a Life plus 10 years sentence, has always maintained his innocence. Kamau Sadiki is now 70 and in poor health with Hepatitis C, cirrhosis of the liver, blood pressure issues, open infectious wounds and sarcoidosis. Every day is a struggle for him, and for his two daughters and grandchildren, who are devastated by the absence of their loving, hard-working father and grandfather, who supported them by working for the telephone company in New York for over eighteen years. 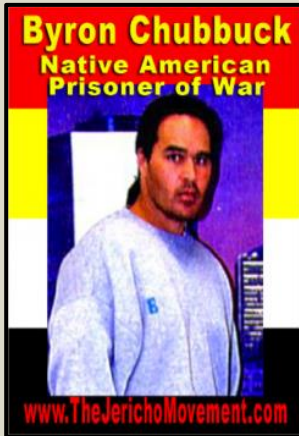

“Oso Blanco became known by the authorities as “Robin the Hood” after the FBI and local gang unit APD officers learned from a CI that he was robbing banks to send thousands of dollars to the Zapatista Rebels of Chiapas regularly during 1998 and 1999. He is now serving 55 years in prison for bank robbery, aggravated assault on the FBI, escape and firearms charges. Oso Blanco defended himself from federal agents in a gun battle on August 13th 1999 at his home in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Although he escaped, he was arrested later that day and sentenced to time in New Mexico’s state Penitentiary. After serving just over a year in New Mexico, he escaped from a prison transport van and almost immediately began robbing banks. He was recaptured a short time later. Oso Blanco never used a gun in any bank robbery, but he has a long history of living by the gun and will not hesitate to use it on the agents of repression or the occupiers of Aztlán who force false laws on the true people of this land. He is not asking for monetary support; he’s only asking that people become aware of indigenous 20 people’s issues. In an interview he expressed “I am still able to hold my head up high and feel the gratification for my work in a world where money, power and destructive industries are regarded far above humanity, indigenous and impoverished peoples and cultures. I cannot help that I got deeply into my work...” “We shall no longer kill Mother Earth and everything else just to have modern technologies and pay for death as tax slaves. We shall rise up refusing to be slaves to commerce and political lies, in our own Land.” “We shall be High master” – High master of the heart Realm of Higher Consciousness. 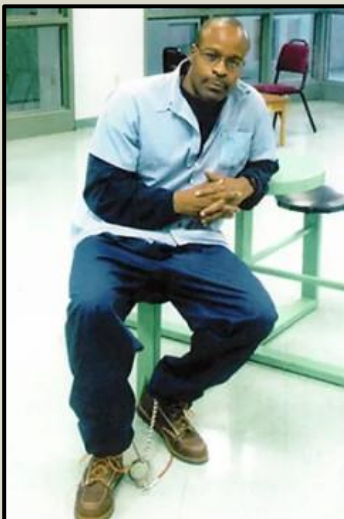

Keith LaMar (Bomani Shakur)

“Lucasville Uprising” of 1993”

In 1989, Keith LaMar (aka Bomani Shakur) was sent to prison at age 19 for murder. He had been living in Cleveland, Ohio, where he sold drugs as a means of survival in the Crack-infested streets he knew as home. On a day that would forever change his life, Keith was robbed at gunpoint and exchanged gunfire with his robbers. He was shot twice in his legs and hit one of the other men in the chest. That young man, once a childhood friend, died. Keith pled guilty and was sent to prison for 18 years-to-life. Four years later, Keith was attempting to put together the broken pieces of his life at the Southern Ohio Correctional Facility, hoping for another

chance at life. It was an Easter Sunday, and the weather had just turned warmer; Keith and about 400 other men were outside exercising in the rec-yard when commotion broke out inside and it became

clear that some type of protest was underway. Keith made a quick decision to slip inside for a few minutes to secure his personal belongings (since his cell assignment was in the area being taken over). Once back out in the yard, he and the others waited to see what would transpire, watching as the bodies of several men were dumped onto the yard.

As Easter came to an end, the Ohio State Highway Patrol rounded up those on the yard and secured them into another part of the facility. Prison records prove that Keith was among them. Though no one could have predicted what exactly was happening, or how it would all result, an 11-day siege ensued. In the end, nine inmates and one guard ultimately lost their lives. When the dust began to settle, the State of Ohio needed someone on whom to pin several of the early inmate deaths. This is where Keith's troubles began...

A few months later, several prisoners were enticed with the promise of early paroles and/or dropped charges if only they would come up with a reasonable story to help the State sweep up the "mess" at their out-of-control prison. They determined Keith would be the fall guy, and they pointed their fingers at him. Thus, to make it all come together convincingly, the prosecution withheld actual confessions from his defense, as well as eyewitness statements that contradicted their fabricated version of events. In spite of zero DNA or forensic evidence, they moved forward with their accusations against Keith. In fact, they made sure his trial would be racially biased in their favor by calling for the removal of the few potential black jurors, and by holding his trial in an all-white county in southern Ohio. In spite of having no motive to kill anyone, no actual proof connecting him, nor any affiliation with any of the groups organizing the uprising, the jury didn't take long to find Keith LaMar guilty of the murder of five of the inmates. He was sentenced to death.

On November 16, 2023, the State intended to execute him (this date has now been postponed until January 13, 2027), even though he has maintained his innocence for three decades, all while being held in indefinite solitary confinement. In the aftermath of the 1993 Lucasville Prison Uprising, the State of Ohio was under public pressure to clean up a multi-million dollar mess, one that included the death of a prison guard and multiple prisoners. After State investigators trampled the crime scene and contaminated any and all potential evidence, they paid jailhouse informants to create a false narrative that implicated Keith, even though he wasn't affiliated with any of the groups involved in the riot. To bolster their claim, the State withheld evidence that would have proven his innocence (including the confession of an actual perpetrator who admitted to murdering one of Keith's alleged victims). His trial was staged in a remote Ohio community known to be highly racist. Any Black prospective jurors were promptly dismissed by the Prosecution, leaving Keith's fate in the hands of an all-white jury, who swiftly sentenced him to death.

* * * * *

Keith's is a story about racialized injustice, State corruption, struggle, perseverance and truth. He has laid it all out in *Condemned*, a soulful, fiery, and captivating book. In it, he traces how the prosecutors fabricated a case against him, then goes on to dismantle their lies by highlighting their inconsistencies. Keith shows clearly how his Constitutional rights were violated by the State of Ohio's willful withholding of evidence favorable to his defense. Most importantly, he compels readers to consider their place within the larger social system, inviting those who would stand on the side of social justice to join him, not just on his behalf, but also for the countless nameless, faceless people caught up in the struggle for humanity.

A documentary film that focuses on the State's intentional railroading of Keith was made available online in October of 2014. In just 36 short minutes, many of the issues about what happened in Keith's legal case are illuminated. The film was updated in 2019 and can be viewed by following this [link](#). 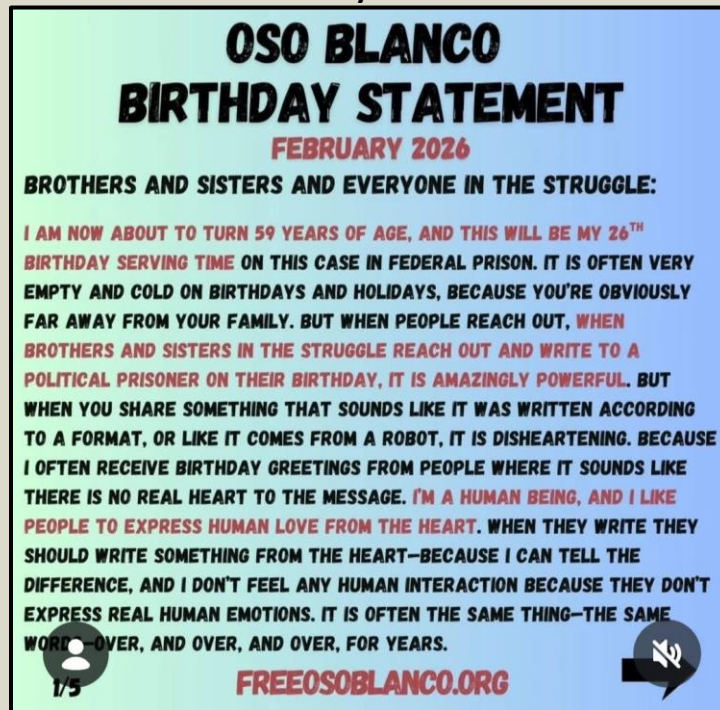

A Message from Kevin Cooper in Memory of Rev. Jesse Jackson

“I’m Kevin Cooper and I am still on Death Row in the state of California in 2026. In 2004, on February 10th, at one minute after midnight, California was planning to torture and murder me via poisonous lethal injection drugs. However, at 11 a.m. on February 9th, the late Reverend Jesse Jackson, Sr. came to San Quentin prison with one of my attorneys and brought me the stay of execution paper work from the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals. But it wasn’t over because the U.S. Supreme Court could still overturn the stay. From 11 a.m. until 6 p.m. Rev. Jackson stayed with me and other visitors in the visiting room. He did everything he could to take my mind off of the fact that I still could be executed if the Supreme Court lifted the stay of execution. He told jokes and made me laugh. He prayed with me and for me. He told me about the struggles we Black people have in the criminal justice system and that the death penalty was no more than a modern day lynching. He told me that we had to have faith that one day we would put an end to the death penalty and I believed him. I believe that still. At six o’clock I was taken to the death chamber but I was not executed. The stay held. I thanked him then and I thank him now for his kindness and his humanity and for caring for everyday people like me. “Reverend Joyce Powell (Rev. Joy) is a long-time community activist, pastor, and magnetic social justice trailblazer who was framed in 2006 for her activism in the city of Rochester, NY against police brutality. A mother of five and grandmother to many, she has dedicated her life to supporting at-risk youth and empowering individuals affected by violence and hardship. She is currently wrongfully incarcerated at the Bedford Hills Correctional Facility in New York state.

Rev. Joy continues to fight for her exoneration and just heard back regarding the motion she recently submitted to the lower court to compel the DA to relinquish material evidence that was never given to her, but was used against her during her trial and appeal. This was a due process violation based on the 5th, 6th, and 14th amendments. Her motion is under review - please look out for updates at her website!

Rev. Joy restarted her paralegal studies in 2024 (with support from Malcolm X Grassroots Movement) and obtained her paralegal certificate on October 15, 2025. She’s also working towards her bachelor’s degree in psychology with Marymount Manhattan College. She continues to feed the hungry inside, sharing the material support she receives with others. She is also an advocate for and supporter of LGBTQ+ people who are incarcerated in Bedford Hills, continuing the work she did before her wrongful incarceration, building connections across the walls.

Along with other people who are incarcerated at Bedford Hills, Rev. Joy continues to experience abuse by male officers (such as coming into the shower while women are naked, with video cameras) and officer-caused delays in receiving medical attention. Officers continue to beat women and drag them without all of their clothing on, including in freezing temperatures. One incident took place as recently as February 7. Rev. Joy continues to advocate for herself and others inside who experience these ongoing abuses.

The Rev. Joy Powell Defense Committee is hosting a Birthday Bash and Fundraiser for her on March 7—in New York City, Atlanta, Ft. Pierce Florida, Rochester NY, and online—to help fundraise for her legal defense and personal needs. Art and zines made by Rev. Joy inside will be sold. Food, games, activities, music, and poetry will be shared. Check out her website (<https://freejoypowell.org/>) for more info on how to join! Rev. Joy thanks her Defense Committee, which meets each week, and all of her supporters, who remind each other that there’s nothing in this world you’ve ever been through that you can’t pull yourself together and make a comeback.

5. Casey Goonan Update 2/15/26 ---Update 2/15/26-from the Casey Support Committee

“Finally! As you may have seen elsewhere, Casey is finally out of the holdover unit at FCI Mendota and is in the transfer pipeline to their designated facility.

At 4 am on Tuesday, 2/11, Casey was woken up, told to pack it up, and then put on the bus before the sun rose. They were transported from Mendota to the SF Federal Bldg and then to the county jail in downtown SF. Casey reported that coming over the hills that morning into the Bay as the sun rose, they felt blessed. Casey, sitting in a van still cuffed up, was able to see the horizon, able to see the sun's light grow and spread over the city and the Bay. While at the SF jail, Casey was able to walk around the unit freely, talk to others, and enjoy phone access with their friends and loved ones in a way not possible for months in that shithole holdover unit. Casey and a member of our committee were able to have a loving, hour long conversation that didn't feel like a rushed whisper through a keyhole.

Casey didn't spend long in SF before they were put on a plane. On Friday, Casey showed up on the BOP inmate locator at FCI Allenwood - Medium, one facility of three in a prison complex located in northern Pennsylvania.

A few notes about Casey's current placement:

- This may be an intermediate placement. We have not confirmed with Casey that this is their permanent designated facility and this may well be a temporary location. All prison systems are opaque and move people around at will according to their own fickle bureaucratic criteria. When we confirm this is to be Casey's designated facility, we will let you know.
- It's always good to write! Address for the facility is below. But know that in addition to this possibly being a short-lived placement, sometimes Casey's mail has been held by the mailroom for weeks or months. We have also found that multiple pieces of mail have been blocked or "lost" as well. So independent of Casey being at Allenwood permanently or temporarily, know that comms through the mail are goofy as well as slow and fully surveilled.
- Conditions have changed already. According to Casey, this current spot is more capable meeting their needs as a diabetic. They are let out of their cell from 8 am to 5 pm, have phone access, and at the time of the last call with fam, Casey was on their way to check out the library (!! of course. If you know Casey...)
- At some point, Casey's counselor told them that they had been given a "Low" security classification. This has not been formally confirmed. So again, we will let you know when we know more. And yes, a Low can be sent to a Medium level facility - Welcome to the byzantine nature of prison regulations and practices.
- All property is surrendered on transfer out of a holdover unit so Casey has to start over in terms of personal property and nutritional supplements from commissary to deal with their diabetes. To send funds to keep Casey's commissary account topped up, you can Venmo Casey's fam - @JuliePetersonG

More on the toll of "holdover life"

Casey spent over 4 months in holdover at Mendota. Holdover - the limbo unit for people being received, moved, etc. - is worse than solitary in many respects. You have no property, no programs, limited access to anything but your tiny cell, and no definite date for getting out. Casey had only minimal access to medical care for their diabetes: insulin only dispensed once per day, insufficient blood sugar checks, mediocre diet, and maximum stress and uncertainty. The poor care had started to permanently damage Casey's eyesight. If they were to continue much longer in holdover, Casey was anticipating needing a new prescription in order to read or see adequately.

Also, every other person that passed through holdover at Mendota only spent a few weeks there. A month in and Casey became in effect the "OG" of the unit, the prisoner housed there the longest, orienting others to the layout and program of the place. Yet again, to those who have been locked up or who have years doing prisoner support, the question at some point becomes "Is this bullshit targeted or is it just random, just industrialized abandonment and they don't give a shit about anybody?"

Well, Casey is a political prisoner. And while everybody inside gets a number and everybody gets put in the uniform, there is nonetheless a wild card or two in the deck for politicals. Consequences can be heavier. And that's another thing for people on the outside to remember and take to heart regarding risks, expectations, and communications with our loved ones inside.

Legal update--Casey has been working on a habeas petition with another legal team in order to appeal their conviction and sentencing. The deadline for this filing will be 12 months from their sentencing (Sept. 23, 2026) so we will report more on this in the coming months as it develops.

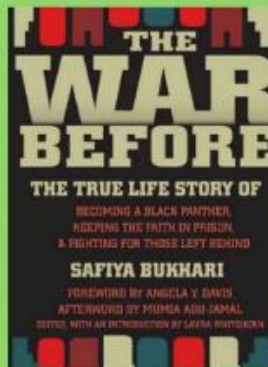

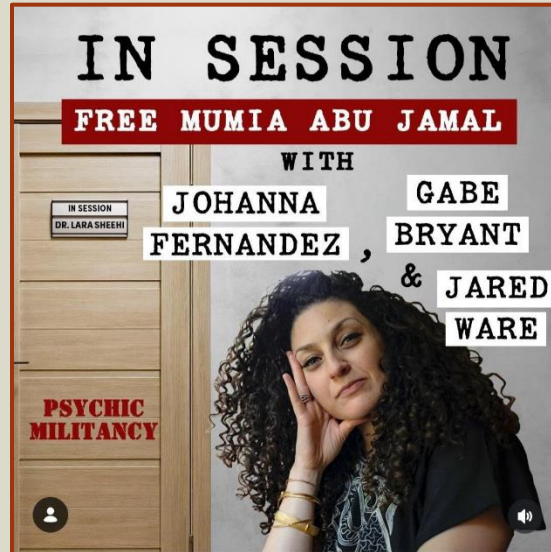

“The Denver Anarchist Black Cross exists to contribute to the defense of social movements, both internally and externally, working against oppression and for self determination.

Since its inception at the beginning of the 20th Century, the mission of the Anarchist Black Cross has been to contribute to the defense of mass movements working for liberation from state and capitalist domination. The most previous incarnation of an Anarchist Black Cross chapter in Denver was snuffed out of existence quite quickly in 2004, after a full scale FBI investigation into the organization was launched to coincide with the security efforts protecting the Democratic National Convention that summer. The resulting FBI investigation spread to include the Great Plains Anarchist Network and dozens of anarchist organizers active in the Midwest.

With this history in mind, but also amidst a backdrop of increasing state attacks on social movements in the United States, we decided to form a new Denver chapter of the ABC. We felt that the time is far past due to organize methods of defense within our communities, and that under the historical banner of the Anarchist Black Cross was one strategic way to proceed with our work.

Historically, the Anarchist Black Cross has played a crucial role in mass movement defense; organizing support and defense of political prisoners and prisoners of war, maintaining physical solidarity against the police during factory and school occupations, organizing self defense and armed defense of social movements, and fulfilling a broad range of roles within the defense of social movements.

We wish to carry on this work and start to explore other avenues of movement defense that have historically not been a major focus of many ABC chapters.

The state and those that wish to destroy movements for liberation attack us on many levels. Support for political prisoners and prisoners of war, organizing against white supremacist and neo-fascist attacks, performing roles of security and physical defense, and organizing self-defense and legal defense on a variety of levels will continue to be a main backbone of our work.

From the Green Scare to the arrest of former Panthers, from the cases of the RNC 8 to mass incarceration and deportations of migrants, the state has been busy attacking our communities and movements over the last several years.

However, we wish to also focus on the internal mechanisms that affect movements and lead to their demise. These internal threats are used to split and destroy movements far before they even become a threat. We envision an ABC chapter capable of contributing to the strengthening of our movement by providing mental, emotional, material, and physical support to its members and their communities. Ultimately, we want to help ensure the strength of our movements from the inside out.

We're still figuring out what all this looks like. We're still working to understand how to provide the best support possible within our social movements and to maintain our movement as a legitimate and strong threat to state, capitalist, white supremacist, patriarchal power and other forms of domination.

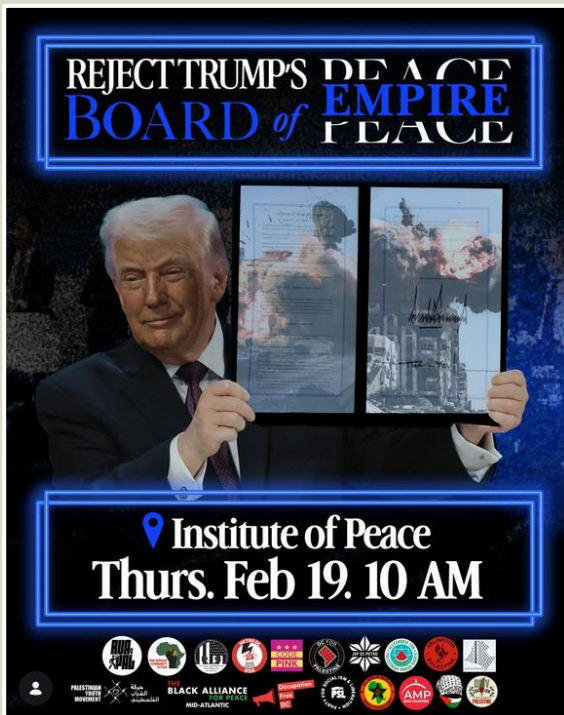

It is a cynical and crude ploy to distract public opinion from the issues at home that are eliciting mass public dissent, and as we’ve seen with Venezuela, a precursor to an illegal military attack. We, along with millions of people in the United States and around the world, reject this inhumane act against the people of Cuba. This is not a policy of national security; it is a deliberate act of economic warfare aimed at strangling an entire population.

President Barack Obama initiated an important effort to normalize relations between the United States and Cuba. The two countries reopened their embassies after they had been closed for 50 years. People across the United States, Cuba, and the entire Western Hemisphere greeted this as a welcome end to the anachronistic Cold War

policies that had dominated the relationship.

But Trump has reversed the path that the Obama administration began. His January 29 Executive Order labels Cuba an ‘unusual and extraordinary threat’ to the United States. This is obviously false, but it provides a pretext to impose severe economic penalties on any country that attempts to deliver oil or trade with Cuba.

The consequences of the new Executive Order will be measured in human suffering:

- Families will be left without power for light, refrigeration, and cooking.
- Hospitals will face impossible choices, risking the closure of wards and the suspension of critical treatments.
- The distribution of food and medicine will be paralyzed.
- The most vulnerable—children, the elderly, and the sick—will bear the brunt of this cruelty.

This policy is unconscionable. It deepens a humanitarian crisis of our own making. Cuba poses no threat to the United States. Starving a population into submission is not diplomacy; it is a form of terrorism. We call on all people of conscience to reject this cruelty and demand an immediate end to the blockade. For over 30 years, the UN General Assembly has voted annually, with an overwhelming majority, to condemn the US embargo on Cuba. Trump must carry out his foreign policy with respect to the wishes of the people of the United States and in accordance with international law. We, the people of the United States, want to have normal relations with Cuba, treat Cuba with equality and respect, and most importantly to see Cuba and the Cuban people as our neighbors and not our enemies. **Let Cuba Live! “*Hatuey Project delegations delivered \$75,000 worth of supplies to Cuba this May and August* (above) Did you know that the 5-year survival rate of childhood leukemia is over 90% with the right medications? The Hatuey Project has launched a new campaign to raise \$75,000 to provide medicines for Cuban children with Leukemia and other cancers to help Cuban doctors overcome the crippling effects of the U.S. blockade. Cuban children and Cuban doctors need our help. Conditions in Cuba have become increasingly difficult over the past few months. Sixty years of an inhumane blockade and an additional two years of being falsely listed as a State Sponsor of Terror by the US State Department has resulted in recent shortages of food, fuel, and essential medicines.

Organizers of the Hatuey Project met with Cuban doctors and nurses at Juan Manuel Márquez Pediatric Hospital in Havana, at the José Luis Miranda Pediatric Hospital in Santa Clara, and with the Institute of Hematology and Immunology in Havana, where they learned that doctors have been unable to purchase much-needed medications and materials.

Despite the incredible medical advances made by the Cuban medical system, **the United States Blockade prevents doctors from accessing basic, life-saving medications for children.**

In this video Dr. José Valdez, the director of the oncology department at Juan Manuel Márquez Pediatric Hospital, tells about the problems he and his patients face: In Cuba, there are medications that could be purchased in third countries but when they have some U.S. component, Cuba is not allowed to buy them. This means that sometimes we do not have the ideal or indicated medications for the specific illness of the child. We use an alternative, which does not give the same result. **It is the children that pay the price for this needless policy.**

While we continue to fight to end the US Blockade against Cuba and to remove Cuba from the State Sponsors of Terrorism List, the people of the United States can stand in solidarity with the Cuban people through material support.

Dear Friend and Fellow Freedom Fighter,

The Spirit of Mandela Coalition, following up on the October 2021 International Tribunal verdict finding the US Guilty of Genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous people (see full verdict [HERE](#)), is calling for the building of a new mass grassroots formation: The Peoples' Senate. The people need to govern and represent themselves in combating genocide and addressing their right to a just and humane existence. Our vision is for the Peoples' Senate, organized directly by our oppressed communities, to grow into a body which will serve that purpose.

Today our communities face the most egregious violations of our human rights since the civil rights and Black power movements of the 1960s and '70s. Conditions we are living under include random mass shootings, right-wing vigilante attacks, police violence and murder, environmental racism, the reassertion of "states rights" (the "right" of states to ignore basic human rights), and healthcare racism. The US government dangerously scapegoats immigrants; causes destabilization, extreme violence, bombing, and killing of Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people all over the globe – and spends billions of dollars to do it; and keeps hundreds of thousands of people living in homelessness and poverty in the US. Our communities are facing targeted attacks against voting rights, workers' rights, women's rights, and Indigenous Peoples' rights as right-wing elected officials and appointed judges roll back decades of hard-won battles for justice. While out-voting right-wing candidates during elections is important, voting alone will not be enough. We must organize to put more pressure on the system for major change.

The US Congress and Senate are representatives of the rich and powerful. They refuse to address the necessity for universal healthcare or a sound nationwide infrastructure providing access to clean water and other necessities. Corporations ignore and violate the needs of the planet while evading their fair share of taxes. US prisons are filled with Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people, many incarcerated for crimes they did not commit and/or serving sentences that far outweigh whatever criminal acts they may have committed. The oppressed national communities of Black, Brown, and Indigenous peoples all have political prisoners and prisoners of war incarcerated since the 1960s until today, who have fought for our liberation and are being held in prison unjustly or only released when near death. We want them all freed now!

Building our own Peoples' Senate will enable us to organize locally from a position of strength and connect local activists with others, in other parts of the country, who may be pursuing similar goals while electing "Senators" who are mandated to represent our interests and demands. A Peoples' Senate can fight for changes that protect and ensure our right to vote, our right to control our own bodies, our right to live free from discrimination as LGBTQ+ people, our rights to living wages and safe working conditions, our rights to sovereignty and dignity, and our rights to live free from state violence and abuse.
