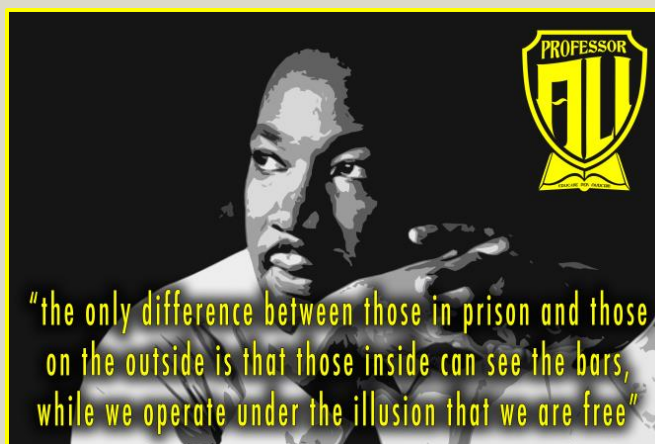
Part of our work is raising funds to support our PPs as well as their families. Additionally, we are assisting our comrades who have finally come home.

Solidarity Statement with Venezuela

01/09/2026

The Jericho Movement for Political Prisoner Amnesty stands in solidarity with The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela and we denounce the extremely grave military aggression perpetrated by the current Government of the United States of America against Venezuelan territory and population in civil and military locations in the city of Caracas, the capital of the Republic, and the states of Miranda, Aragua, and La Guaira. And we call for the immediate release of President Nicolás Maduro and First Lady Cilia Flores.

Jericho is appalled by the wanton and imperialist nature of the kidnapping of President Nicolás Maduro and First Lady Cilia Flores. We understand that President Maduro stated in court: "I consider myself a Prisoner of War." And POWs (according to moribund international law) have rights not being afforded to Maduro and Flores.

The colonial attack on Venezuela is a power grab in order to extrapolate natural resources, particularly oil. This act constitutes a flagrant violation of the Charter of the United Nations, especially Articles 1 and 2, which enshrine respect for sovereignty, the legal equality of States, and the prohibition of the use of force.

Jericho Movement Statement on Prison Hunger Strikers

Statement of Support with Prisoner Hunger Strikes in Solidarity with Palestine

01/13/2026

The Jericho Movement for Amnesty for Political Prisoners stands in solidarity with hunger strikes carried out by activists affiliated with Palestine Action, a direct-action network that targets British facilities linked to Israeli arms production. We acknowledge the bold sacrifice and commitment of those, the Filton 24, who all were denied bail and have been imprisoned for over a year. The six prisoners held on remand in the UK for alleged offenses relating to Palestine Action have started hunger striking since late 2025 demanding an Israeli weapons firm shuts its UK sites.

The detainees are demanding immediate bail, transfers to prisons closer to their families, and an end to the group's designation under UK counterterrorism legislation. They are also calling for the UK

government to cease cooperation with companies supplying weapons to Israel. Their arrests relate to alleged property damage and break-ins at sites connected to Elbit Systems, including its UK subsidiary in Bristol and a Royal Air Force base in Oxfordshire.

The UK government designates Palestine action a terrorist organization. These hunger strikes are framed within a long history of Irish prison resistance, with both movements using hunger as a potent political weapon, fostering solidarity and drawing stark historical comparisons. The protests highlight shared tactics of resistance and the use of hunger strikes against unjust detention, with activists facing serious health risks including death.

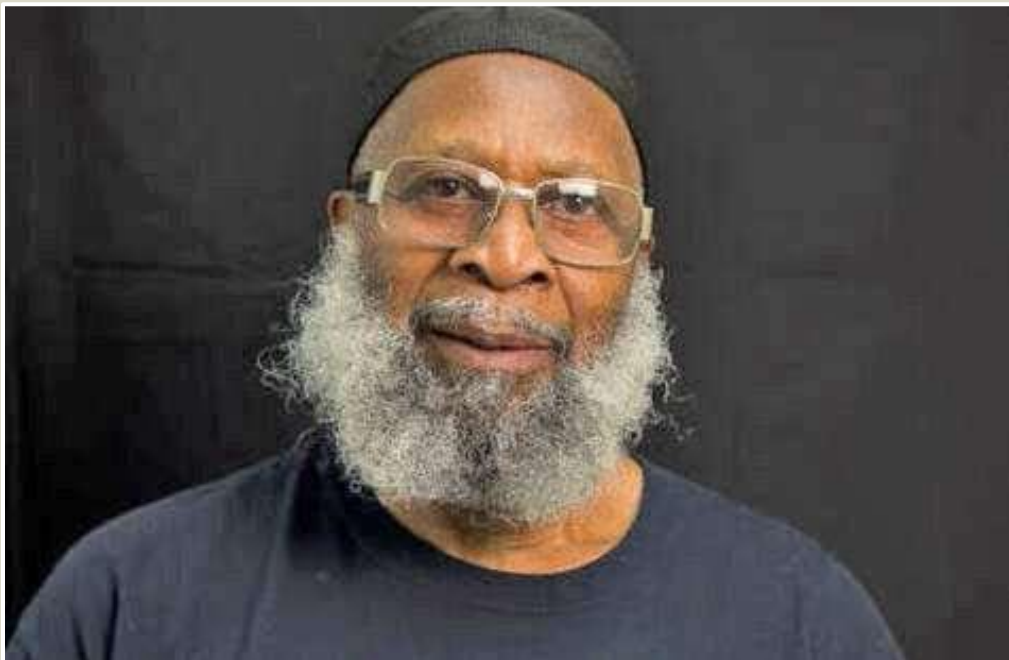

Sekou Odinga ¡Presente!

Today is the anniversary of Sekou Odinga's transition to the Ancestors and we miss him deeply!

"Sekou Odinga, a former United States political prisoner for 33 years stemming from his involvement in the Black Liberation Movement, **passed away on Jan. 12, 2024**. Odinga was a part of several of the most impactful organizations in US Black liberation history, including Malcolm X's Organization of Afro-American Unity, the Black Panther Party and the Black Liberation Army. Odinga is also known for his role in the escape of fellow political prisoner Assata Shakur, who lived free in Cuba until her transition on September 25, 2025.

Odinga was released from prison in 2014. Regarding his role in Shakur's escape, he never pleaded guilty to charges, but told *Democracy Now!* in 2016 that he was "proud to be associated with the liberation of Assata Shakur."

Speaking about what drew him to the program of the Black Panther Party, Odinga told *Democracy Now!*, "What attracted me more than anything else was the stand against police brutality, because like all the other ghettos in this country or Black areas of this country, police brutality was running rampant. From my first memory of it was – in New York – was little Clifford Glover, who was murdered out in my neighborhood in Jamaica, Queens ... What we were really concerned about was trying to put some kind of control on the police or at least be in a position that we could counter some of what they were doing." Odinga's words reflect the legacy of Black liberation movements throughout US history, which from the mass movement sparked by the murder of Emmett Till to the 2020 uprisings after the murder of George Floyd, share a common outrage at the brutal violence waged against Black people. "Sekou Odinga, a dedicated revolutionary, believed in our common humanity and the need to resist inhumanity anywhere on the planet," Jalil Muntaqim, former political prisoner and lifelong Black liberation fighter told Peoples Dispatch. Muntaqim is the co-founder of the Jericho Movement, an organization fighting for amnesty and freedom for the political prisoners of the US.

"As a Muslim, [Odinga] was compelled to do so, as it is instructed in the Holy Qur'an 'to fight tumult and oppression wherever you may find it; tumult and oppression is worse than slaughter.' Sekou Odinga lived to manifest this mandate in his entire being, actualizing the need to resist in order to overcome white supremacy and capitalist-imperialism, the scourge of the planet. Long Live the warrior spirit of Sekou Odinga."



Nino Brown, an organizer with the Jericho Movement, told Peoples Dispatch: “We in the Jericho Movement were honored to host Sekou, break bread and learn from him so we can continue the fight against oppression and exploitation. He is known to many as ‘Baba Sekou’ and rightfully so.”

“While his life has ended, his legacy lives on with all of his comrades and this next generation of revolutionaries,” Brown continued.

“[Odinga] was the epitome of an upstanding Black man and a revolutionary who refused to let this rotten system break him even as it held him captive for over 30 years,” said JD, also an organizer with the Jericho Movement. “And thankfully he got to

transition with his loved ones by his side instead of behind enemy lines.” In 1965, Odinga joined Malcolm X’s Organization of Afro-American Unity, later leaving the organization to found the Bronx chapter of the Black Panther Party. In 1969, Odinga became a part of the group of BPP defendants dubbed the “Panther 21,” who were accused of planning coordinated attacks on two police stations and one education office in New York City. The trial eventually collapsed, following a grassroots campaign in support of the defendants.

Following the increasing police and FBI repression against the BPP, Odinga joined many activists in moving towards underground organizations, such as the Black Liberation Army.” (“This story first appeared on peoplesdispatch.org”). Source: Email.

Atlanta victory! 61 charges dismissed in the Cop City RICO case

“Atlanta, GA – On Tuesday, December 30, after two years of local pressure and national support, a Georgia judge issued an order dismissing RICO charges against 61 activists who protested the construction of Cop City.

The ruling comes just months after the charges of three activists wrongfully charged with money laundering in connection to the administration of the Atlanta Solidarity bail funds in 2024 were also dropped due to a flimsy legal argument and increasing pressure from the community.

In his order, Fulton County Superior Court Judge Kevin Farmer said that the attorney general did not have the authority to bring Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations (RICO) Act charges and had to seek permission from the governor to do so but did not in this case. “The attorney general acknowledged that no prior authority was granted by the governor to bring RICO charges,” Farmer wrote in his order. Legal experts have pointed out that the indictment, which groups the activists together in what the state tried to deem as an organized criminal conspiracy, was an overreach in power by the attorney general's office.

“Judge Farmer correctly dismissed the indictment because the prosecution did not follow the law when filing these charges,” attorney Amanda Clark Palmer said in a statement on Tuesday calling the state's case a “bloated, tortured and overblown prosecution.”

The RICO indictment orchestrated by state Attorney General Chris Carr, who is planning to run for governor, was the culmination of a massive wave of repression in the face of the Stop Cop City movement. The movement, made up of activists, community members and a coalition of organizations in Atlanta, saw all forms of attack by the state over the last two years.

In 2023, in the months following the police murder of activist Manuel Paez Teran, known as Tortugueta, in the Weelaunee Forest at the construction site of Cop City, 69 protesters were indicted on bogus charges: 61 activists on state RICO charges, five activists on domestic terrorism and arson charges, and three on money laundering charges.

While the state has not dropped the domestic terrorism charges, the RICO and money laundering charges being dismissed reveal a pattern of failure and weakness in the larger efforts to intimidate people into silence and criminalize mass resistance to the militarization of the police.

This victory highlights not just the weakness of the regressive forces in power but the true strength of the people and the power of bold and courageous solidarity.” fightbacknews.org

Behind ICE's Murder of Queer Woman Renee Good: Rising Immigrant Solidarity

The brazen murder of Minneapolis queer woman Renee Nicole Macklin Good by agents of Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) on January 7th was only the latest episode in an intensifying campaign of racist repression and suppression of dissent. The Trace (a newsroom investigating gun violence) has identified [16 incidents in the past year](#) in which immigration agents opened fire -- resulting in at least 4 deaths and 7 injuries -- and another 15 incidents in which agents held someone at gunpoint since Trump's immigration crackdown began last June. [Since Trump's inauguration, there have been 32 reported deaths in ICE custody](#). Both in the shootings and deaths in custody, nearly all targeted were people of color. With the MAGA/billionaire/Christian right forces intent on ethnic cleansing, migrant punishment and removal from the U.S., the migrant solidarity movement has been surging. Renee was the latest example, a courageous poet and mother of three determined to support her siblings of color, especially migrants from Somalia and other Global South countries. In a [public statement](#), her wife Becca -- who was present and outraged at the killing -- paid tribute to Renee's "kindness...and overarching belief that...we are here to love each other, care for each other, and keep each other safe." Becca added, "On Wednesday, January 7th, we stopped to support our neighbors. We had whistles. They had guns. This murder was fueled by misogyny and hatred of perceived white "traitors." Meanwhile, corporate media reporting as usual largely equalized the Trump Administration's lies about Renee's "domestic terrorism" and the truth about what she actually did -- despite multiple, clear videos to the contrary. The reader/viewer was left to [sort it out](#). At the same time, many media outlets -- even some progressive ones -- continued the age-old invisibilizing of queer lives by leaving out any reference to Becca, at least in initial reporting.

In the Twin Cities of Minneapolis-St. Paul, communities of color -- especially Somalis -- have borne the brunt of this rising terrorism. Increasingly, longtime residents are being violently snatched from their homes, kidnapped and incarcerated, and migrants and allies alike are being sprayed with toxic agents and arrested. This has only fueled the migrant solidarity movement locally and nationally.

On this special Out-FM program, we'll talk about these all these issues and more with three Minneapolis-based guests:

- **Mira Altobell-Resendez**, a non-binary Minnesotan fighting for legalization for all and an end to deportations with the Minnesota Immigrant Rights Action Committee,
- **Jess Sundin**, a longtime community organizer active in the community response to the current massive, militarized ICE deployment in Minnesota. She is a leader of Freedom Road Socialist Organization; organizer with Twin Cities Coalition for Justice; and a grand jury resister, targeted by the FBI for her international solidarity work. She is also a lesbian mom, who lives just blocks from where Renee Good was killed by ICE agents last week.
- **Malika Dahir**, a Somali community activist who is Executive Director of Reviving the Islamic Sisterhood for Empowerment (RISE).

An Open Letter from Original Black Panther Party Members to Black (Hip-Hop) Artists Who Have an Interest in Our Community (T.I., KILLER MIKE, CARDI B, KANYE WEST, BEYONCE', JAY-Z, P-DIDDY, LUDACRIS, 50-CENT, and others)

"Greetings and Solidarity to each of you. In recognition of your individual voice, influence, and cultural following among current generations of Black people/Africans in the Diaspora and on the continent, we salute you.

While we only know you from the public domain, we know that many of you come from backgrounds where you faced poverty, police brutality, lack of healthcare and other forms of oppression like most Black people. We all recognize that we are in a watershed period of economic and government failure, a pandemic and now a resistance movement from which things will never emerge the same.

What we all do in this period will directly impact the fortunes, survival and freedom dreams of Black People, and others around the world who suffer from the same oppression. Whether its South American Favelas, South African Shanty Towns, Palestinian territories or the Black urban ghettos of racist America, capitalism and white supremacy has turned the entire world into a ghetto for the profits of a few. So, we should pay attention to each other, because here, in the heart of racist America we are all we have, and along with our true allies, are truly all we need.

Individually we who write this letter are former members of the original [Black Panther Party](#), co-founded in 1966 by the late [Huey P. Newton](#), and Bobby Seale in Oakland, California. We were targets of the FBI's infamous Counter Intelligence Program (codename [COINTELPRO](#)) which killed many of our comrades, including [Fred Hampton](#), Mark Clark, and numerous other Panthers and revolutionary freedom fighters. We are veterans of government search and destroy missions that forced our beloved Comrade Assata Shakur into exile. We are former Black Political Prisoners who spent decades in U.S. prisons, like our comrades [Russell Maroon Shoatz](#), Romaine "Chip" Fitzgerald, [Sundiata Acoli](#), [Jalil Muntagim](#), and [Mumia Abu-Jamal](#) who are still locked down today. In short, we were on the front line of government efforts to kill and destroy the Black radical movements for civil/human rights including the right to self-determination. <https://youtu.be/UK0Onr8gDSU>

Some of us were also racist law enforcement's worst nightmare, armed combatants in the revolutionary Black underground, the [Black Liberation Army \(BLA\)](#). Much of our history in our people's struggle has been kept away from you and seemingly unavailable to your generation as you reinvent what was done in the past. Who Isn't a Domestic Terrorist:

19th Prairieland Defendant Should Concern Us All

The Trump administration and the State of Texas continue their campaign to paint anyone as a "[domestic terrorist](#)". This time, they arrested Lucy, the [19th Prairieland Defendant](#), under accusations of [Hindering Prosecution of Terrorism](#). Why? For allegedly having Signal calls and teaching folks how to delete Signal messages. These cases in North Texas should concern us all. They are showing in real time the lengths that the government will go to bring to life their [fantasies](#) of "Antifa". While dealing with a completely unrelated case in an entirely different county, *three* prosecutors demanded that Lucy participate in a "free talk" with their agents: the Tarrant County District Attorney, Johnson County District Attorney, and U.S. Attorney General. Despite the way they confidently talk about the Prairieland Defendants, the multiple prosecutors are still looking for information on the [July 4th noise demonstration](#) and subsequent events. Shortly after, federal and state agents arrested Lucy under

these extremely questionable charges. Tellingly, the government only arrested her after failing to get her to “free talk”, months after it already had the alleged information against her. In jail, the State’s pressure campaign continues against Lucy.

But Lucy’s case is just the newest shocking development in the government’s first “Antifa” prosecution and [broader agenda of repression](#). [Des](#), a Green Card holder, is federally indicted for [allegedly moving a box of zines](#). Savanna and others have federal and state indictments [despite being arrested far from](#) where the shooting allegedly happened. Dario, currently the only defendant not in pretrial detention, was indicted in Johnson County for [allegedly removing someone](#) from a group chat. Meanwhile, the State’s raids and repression have continued unchecked, including an invasive search and seizure of [the house of a Denton City Council candidate](#). **NOBEL LAUREATES NOMINATE INTERNATIONAL PEACE RESEARCH
ASSOCIATION AND PROFESSOR MATT MEYER FOR 2026 NOBEL PEACE PRIZE**

“Earlier Winners Criticize 2025 Award to Venezuela’s Machado”

“We are happy to announce that Spirit of Mandela (SoM)'s own Matt Meyer, a life-long campaigner for the freedom of US political prisoners and Secretary-General Emeritus of the International Peace Research Association (IPRA), was formally nominated - along with IPRA as an organization - for the 2026 Nobel Peace Prize. Two leading progressive Nobel Peace laureates, Mairead Corrigan Maguire of Northern Ireland and former political prisoner Adolfo Perez Esquivel of Argentina, put Matt Meyer and IPRA in nomination for the prize, in part to challenge the Norwegian Nobel Committee's controversial 2025 Prize to Venezuelan far-right, anti-socialist Maria Machado, who Perez Esquivel warned was being used as "an instrument of empire."

The nomination was endorsed by other leading global peacemakers and Nobel prize winners, and officially sent to the Nobel Committee on January 19, 2026, celebrated as Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day throughout the world. Matt Meyer responded by noting:

For me, the main honor is in having colleagues who I deeply respect spotlight the ongoing work that a number of us have been doing together. Mairead and Adolfo have been joined by Palestinian comrade Joyce Ajlouny, South African comrade Thandi Tutu-Gxashe, Finnish former President Tarja Halonen, leaders of the International Peace Bureau, and many others - all of whom energize me to redouble my efforts. Together, we must work harder to build unified, collective efforts for lasting peace: decolonization and demilitarization, resistance to ongoing genocides and oppression, and the development of sustainable, beloved communities of freedom, self-determination, liberation, and love.

Internationally, Matt spotlighted the work that he and IPRA have done with the Occupied People's Forum, bringing together freedom fighters from the resistance movements of still-colonized Palestine and Puerto Rico, Kurdistan/Rojava and Kashmir, Western Sahara and West Papua, Ambazonia and Tibet.

Within the US and Turtle Island, Matt is part of the coalition calling for a massive convergence on July 4, 2026 in Atlanta, Georgia. Celebrating 250+ Years of Resistance, this mobilization against genocide follows the 2021 International Tribunal which found the US Guilty of five counts of historic and ongoing genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous Peoples. The July 4th convergence, led by original Black Panthers, former political prisoners, the Community Movement Builders/Stop Cop City movement, Cooperation Jackson, Black Workers for Justice, and others, is being built as a broad, non-sectarian, space to unite progressive peoples in formulating positive, alternative, peoples-centered structures. Many in the mobilization are calling for the creation of an ongoing Peoples Senate as part of a long-term strategy for change.” Source: Email.

"Israel has come home to roost in Minnesota. The people of Minneapolis and St. Paul have become the Palestinians of Minnesota. The residents of the Twin Cities are experiencing the loss of sovereignty and civil rights that Palestinians have suffered for over eight decades.

The *L'Etoile du Nord* (the Star of the North) state has been besieged by thousands of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and Border Patrol agents. The Twin Cities are now occupied communities, surveilled and under attack from their own government.

The militarism, violence and terrorism Israel has rehearsed on Palestinians in occupied Gaza and the West Bank have reached into America's heartland and bled into the nation's political system.

The tactical and ideological similarities between ICE and the Israeli Occupation Forces (IOF) are easily recognizable. These similarities are rooted in decades of joint training programs, shared technology and surveillance. Thousands of federal agents have participated in Israeli "security" training programs.

Simulating the reality of occupation in Palestine, militarized federal agents patrol American neighborhoods, abducting residents. Without warrants, unidentified men armed with assault rifles, conduct raids, drag people from their homes, pull them from vehicles, detain and even kill them, as evidenced this month in the deaths of U.S. citizens, Renee Good and Alex Pretti. Masked agents treat protestors as threats, using chemical and sublethal weapons against them.

Thousands have been forcibly detained and held in ICE detention centers without due process. Since the beginning of 2026, six deaths have been recorded. And in 2025, ICE's deadliest year in two decades, 32 people died..." 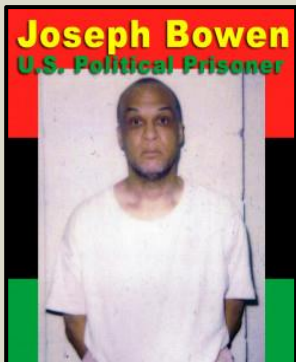

The "Virgin Island Five" are a group of activists accused of murdering eight people in the U.S. Virgin Islands. The murders took place during a turbulent period of rebellion on the Islands. The island was put under virtual martial law, and eventually five men: Ismail Ali, Warren (Aziz) Ballantine, Meral (Malik) Smith, Raphael (Kwesi) Joseph, and Hanif Shabazz Bey were apprehended and then charged with the attack. All the men were known supporters of the Virgin Island independence movement. The five were charged after being subjected to vicious torture in order to extract 16 confessions. They were beaten, hung from their feet and necks from trees, subject to electric shocks with cattle prods, had plastic bags tied over their heads and had water forced up their noses by the "defenders of the law."..." "Joe-Joe" Bowen is a Black Liberation Army (BLA) Prisoner of War, serving two life sentences for the assassination of a prison warden and deputy warden, as well as an attempted prison break which resulted in a five-day standoff after his initial arrest. Personal Background-"A native of Philadelphia, Joe-Joe was a young member of the "30th and Norris Street" gang before his incarceration politicized him. Released in 1971, his outside activism was cut short a week following his release when Joe-Joe was confronted by an officer of the

notoriously brutal Philadelphia police department. The police officer was killed in the confrontation, and Bowen fled. After his capture and incarceration, Bowen became a Black Liberation Army combatant, defiant to authorities at every turn." "Joe-Joe was sent to the Federal Prison in Marion, IL, where he met up with other political prisoners and prisoners of war, such as Sundiata Acoli, Hanif Shabazz Bey and Ray Luc Levasseur. 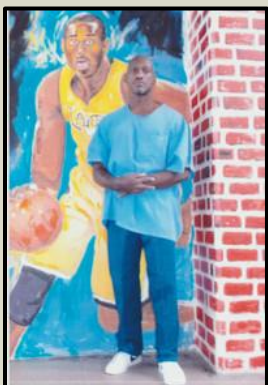

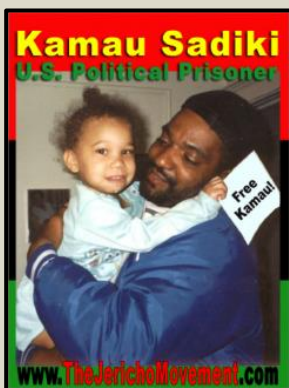

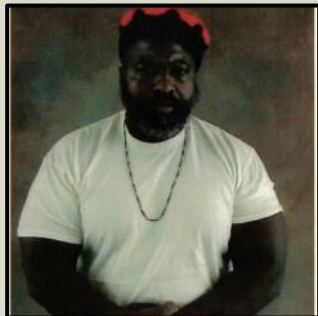

Kamau Sadiki is a father, grandfather, and Political Prisoner. He is also a veteran of the Black Panther Party, wrongfully convicted when the FBI, in their efforts to recapture Assata Shakur, convinced Atlanta police to reopen a 30-year-old cold case murder of a Fulton County police officer, and charge Mr. Sadiki. The police told Kamau that if he worked with them and "got Assata to leave Cuba" and go to some other country where they could apprehend her, they would not prosecute on the false police killing charge. The police offer was rejected, and Kamau, now serving a Life plus 10 years sentence, has always maintained his innocence. Kamau Sadiki is now 70 and in poor health with Hepatitis C, cirrhosis of the liver, blood pressure issues, open infectious wounds and sarcoidosis. Every day is a struggle for him, and for his two daughters and grandchildren, who are devastated by the absence of their loving, hard-working father and grandfather, who supported them by working for the telephone company in New York for over eighteen years. 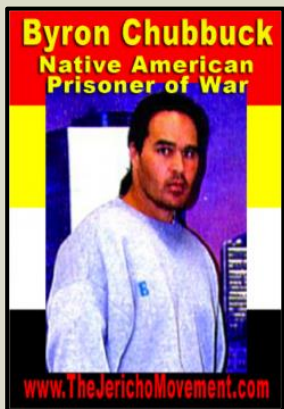

"Oso Blanco became known by the authorities as "Robin the Hood" after the FBI and local gang unit APD officers learned from a CI that he was robbing banks to send thousands of dollars to the Zapatista Rebels of Chiapas regularly during 1998 and 1999. He is now serving 55 years in prison for bank robbery, aggravated assault on the FBI, escape and firearms charges. Oso Blanco defended himself from federal agents in a gun battle on August 13th 1999 at

his home in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Although he escaped, he was arrested later that day and sentenced to time in New Mexico's state Penitentiary. After serving

just over a year in New Mexico, he escaped from a prison transport van and almost immediately began robbing banks. He was recaptured a short time later. Oso Blanco never used a gun in any bank robbery, but he has a long history of living by the gun and will not hesitate to use it on the agents of repression or the occupiers of Aztlán who force false laws on the true people of this land. He is not asking for monetary support; he's only asking that people become aware of indigenous 20 people's issues. In an interview he expressed "I am still able to hold my head up high and feel the gratification for my work in a world where money, power and destructive industries are regarded far above humanity, indigenous and impoverished peoples and cultures. I cannot help that I got deeply into my work...." "We shall no longer kill Mother Earth and everything else just to have modern technologies and pay for death as tax slaves. We shall rise up refusing to be slaves to commerce and political lies, in our own Land." "We shall be High master" – High master of the heart Realm of Higher Consciousness. Please support the Brown Berets, please send aid to the EZLN, I AM OSO BLANCO de Aztlán"

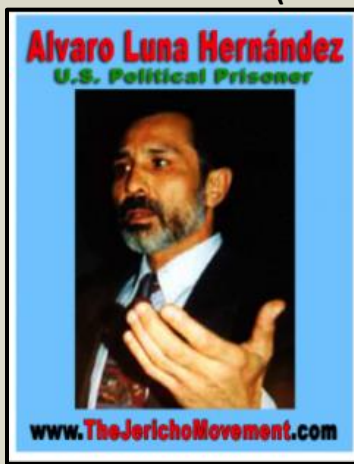

Alvaro Luna Hernandez (Xinachtli) is a political prisoner of the State of Texas and the U.S. government. He is serving a 50 year prison sentence for an "aggravated assault" conviction stemming from a July 1996 incident in which he disarmed a Brewster County Sheriff who was attempting to shoot him. Alvaro vehemently denies the charge that he assaulted the Sheriff. To Mexican-Americans in the cities, slums, plains, deserts, and prison cages of the Southwest he is a civil rights hero, a Chicano freedom fighter true to his barrio roots and eternally fearless in the face of injustice. For years, he has been internationally recognized by amnesty movements and human rights lawyers and experts as a U.S.

political prisoner, yet inside the United States, the name Alvaro Luna Hernandez remains largely elusive on the lips of progressives and social justice advocates.

Xinachtli (Nahuatl, meaning “seed”) is an anarchist communist community organizer and Chicano movement revolutionary, currently imprisoned in Texas. Formerly known as Alvaro Luna Hernandez, he worked diligently in the barrio on civil and human rights issues, known widely for his legal skills. Gaining international recognition as the national coordinator of the Ricardo Aldape Guerra Defense Committee, Xinachtli was instrumental in helping to free Mexican national Aldape Guerra from Texas’ death row, where he had been framed for the murder of a police officer.

In July 1996 Xinachtli was arrested after disarming a County Sheriff who was attempting to shoot him. After defending himself at trial, Xinachtli was sentenced to 50 years in prison for aggravated assault, a charge he vehemently denies. While imprisoned, Xinachtli continues to write frequently, has helped to organize multiple prison strikes, and has been held in solitary confinement for the last 19 years and counting. Xinachtli is a prolific jailhouse lawyer, as referenced by Mumia Abu Jamal in his book Jailhouse Lawyers: Prisoners Defending Prisoners v the USA. Xinachtli assists many prisoners in seeking new trials, and filing suits against the repressive, inhumane Texas prison system.

Xinachtli was recently denied parole again. His next parole hearing will be in 2027.

Kwame Beans Shakur: Contradictions on organizing in post neo-colonial north amerikkka

“Today, this minute, this hour (as Malcolm would say), i have come to realize that picking up the gun was/is the easy part. The difficult part is the day to day organizing, educating, and showing the people by example what needs to be done to create a new society. The hard, painstaking work of changing ourselves into new beings, of loving ourselves and our people, and working with them daily to create a new reality — this is the first revolution, that internal revolution... It may take a little longer to do it the hard way, slowly and methodically, building a movement step by step and block by block, but doing it this way is designed to build a strong foundation that will withstand the test of time and the attack of the enemy... If we truly are to create a new society, we must build a strong foundation” — Safiya Bukhari

Today, this minute, this hour, in this new era of community movement/nation building, We find ourselves in a predicament that is not new or unique at all to our course of struggle. It is the same set of contradictions that opposed those before us, yet they still exist within our ranks to stagnate and erode the manifestation of our political line. i am speaking about the failure to properly study & struggle around our theory and ideology. Revolution, national liberation and decolonization are based on a science, and when this science is overlooked it goes against the aims & objectives that We have set forth to achieve our goals. As new Afrikans, i am referring to the PG-RNA/NAIM and the failure to dissect and apply New Afrikan Political Science (NAPS). As abolitionist and revolutionary freedom fighters, i am referring to PLM and the overall prison movement as it relates to analyzing both past & present orgs and lines needed to build infrastructure and applying international law to liberating our

PPs/POWs. We are not the majority party in a underdeveloped third world nation whose people are born keenly aware of Our oppression and captive status as neo-colonial subjects. Our colonial experience is unique and has been methodically altered and mastered over a period of 400+ years into its own applicable slave science. Therefore, simply existing as a Provisional Government on these shores, holding elections known only to our own conscious citizens, sprinkled in unknown numbers amongst the masses is insufficient. In this post neo-colonial era, Our people are no longer fighting to be free from the shackles of U.S imperialism in pursuit of national independence/self-government because they have no idea that they are still slaves. The need to separate from their birth certificates & social security numbers, proclaiming their nationality and combating the genocidal tactic of being forced to give live birth in U.S hospitals are foreign concepts to them because our leaders have abandoned dialectical materialist philosophy. Failing to expose the politics and class contradictions to the people is itself a direct contradiction to everything we know about creating a social climate geared toward gaining their support for a revolution. Through the application of criticism & self-criticism, an open and honest evaluation can be done to study our shortcomings and setbacks. Our forerunners studied and observed the many anti-colonial peoples wars & national liberation struggles around the world, from Queen Mother Moore, Malcolm X and the Obeideles; to Sekou Odinga, Jilil Muntaqim and Jihad Abdulmumit — We have traveled internationally building allies in pursuit of self-determination. This led us on the righteous path from civil rights to fighting for international human rights, from lawsuits and the domestic use of U.S KKKourts, to the development of international tribunals and forming The Peoples Senate. Yet, in 58 years the PG-RNA has failed to make any significant concrete growth toward decolonization or regaining the international support of our allied nations. Now, it is apparent based on the class/national consciousness of our founding members as well as the founding documents that our nation was built upon that this stagnation is not based on incorrect lines or ideas. So, where is the error and who is responsible for our collective setbacks? Lenin said that without revolutionary theory there can be no revolution. He was correct in that concept, but let me take it a step further and ask: what good is theory without it being turned into applicable forms of action and practice? One thing our movement isn't lacking is a philosophy or theoretical foundation, however, by failing to have fully competent cadre pushing and maintaining the political line to each and every member during the recruitment and training stage there will continue to be a disconnect. From birth We only know what We are told by our family, school, church, gov, etc. and We see all too well how easily We are misguided into believing or simply not questioning the laws or function of society. The same goes for the org, movement or nation, and those in leadership have a responsibility to adhere to all laws & policies that has been put in place to guide us on our new path. In order for u. s. capitalism/imperialism and racism to function and survive as a global empire, it must keep its captive oppressed nations in a totalitarian state (controlling the people of a country in a strict way with complete power that cannot be opposed), or relating to a political regime based on subordination of the individual to the state and strict control over all aspects of the life and productive capacity of the nation esp. by coercive measures, as censorship and terrorism). And therefore the first act of the colonizer must be to strip us of any knowledge/science of self, wipe out all original content and implement our minds with foreign data. The individual slave or captive nation held within the oppressor nation must be frozen in a permanent state of codependency to prevent any real separation or independence. With that being said, We are overlooking the fundamental transition period and process for successful decolonization. If it is understood that colonialism is a process, and beyond the physical kidnapping and captivity of a colony/group, it has to colonize the mind, spirit and culture of its subject for the end goal of complete totalitarianism, then our leaders and the orgs, movements, nations struggling to counter that with decolonization have to fully understand that it TOO is a process. At some point our captors realized that they needed a science of controlling slaves for the

long term objective. That science was neocolonialism, and it's "success" and crippling effects are evident in the way our revolutionary abolitionist attempt to go about "separating," "liberating" the people, or "overthrowing" the current system. The conscious orgs/citizens who make up the NAIM are suppose to be employing NAPS in ALL social spheres of life to educate, foster and nurture its members into cadre capable of agitating, educating, organizing, mobilizing the unconscious masses and poor working class around tangible decolonization programs that allow them to put a face/name on capitalism and completely see the dialectical/historical social process they experienced. Without that method, process, program or purpose, We have a movement and PG with no tangible foundation spewing revolutionary rhetoric. Trying to convince masses of people who not only still have an amerikkkan colonial mentality, but even those who are in a conscious state of rebellion or organizing, and are still tied to this system on a educational, economic, political, and agricultural level that they should separate from the u.s capitalist class structure and fight for land, independence, socialism/communism, anarchy, etc.

When the individual, org, movement or governmental worker is allowed to side step all the fundamental stages required to transition the people toward decolonization, We/they are engaging in counter revolutionary activity. The consequence and results have led to the appointment of incapable, underdeveloped comrades in positions of authority; dysfunction & chaos in the PG/PCC; decades of sectarianism and fragmentation; confusion and uncertainty within the overall movement, and a continuum/normalcy of struggling in a low tide. The masses have had no steady presence from the PG-RNA, nor have they had any signs of tangibility or education that the nation exist. Aside from failing to adopt or develop a policy on cadre development, this evaluation highlights another harsh reality of trying to organize anti-capitalist movements in post neo-colonial north amerikkka. We tend to view neocolonialism thru a narrow lense and use it as a negative term to identify the petty bourgeois class enemies & uncle Toms like Obama, Al Sharpton, Jesse Jackson etc. But the entire New Afrikan Nation is a captive neo-colony, again, whose life and productivity is subordinate and dependent to the u.s totalitarian empire.

We as a nation own no land, we have no economic structure that offers jobs, no schools to send our youth, and no food source; so the reality is that even the most militant individual including the President/Ministers in the PG-RNA and other prison abolitionist or Black nationalist at the highest level of political consciousness need u.s currency to pay rent/mortgage, send their children to daycare, pay for food, clothing and all other daily essentials in order to survive, but do not control or produce on our own. neo-colonialism doesn't afford its dependents the time or opportunity to wage a national liberation struggle, nor does capitalism create space for the poor lower working class to stop production long enough to organize and overthrow it — the average worker who has the ability or power to demand economic change cannot afford to go w/o pay to stage a strike or work stoppage. There is no real sense of urgency or need from even the poorest, oppressed individuals or class to go thru the hard, painstaking and arduous task of what it takes to build infrastructure and transition themselves into a sustainable state of self determination. We have to be open and honest and analyze this aspect of our revolutionary leadership and its relationship, or lack there of to the masses, who also see no immediate need to leave the comforts of slumber in their amerikkkan dream for the "new society" we have failed to materialize. This is because the poorest, oppressed people who historically are those with the most potential to wage a peoples war — are still living more comfortable and pacified by neo-colonialism in the u.s than those who have nothing to lose and everything to gain around the world. The u.s gov showed the people with COINTELPRO what happens to revolutionary freedom fighters who truly dare to struggle/win, and while those who survived languished in prison or exile the last 50 years, capitalism/colonialism morphed again, strengthened its stranglehold on us all the while making conditions a little more comfortable and rocked the tread to sleep.

“Consciousness grows in spirals. Growth implies feeding and being fed. we feed consciousness by feeding people, addressing ourselves to their needs, the basic and social needs, working, organizing toward a united national left. After the people have created something that they are willing to defend, a wealth of new ideals and an autonomous subsistence infrastructure, [then] they are ready to be brought into “open” conflict with the ruling class and its supporters. This conflict must extend to every level of capitalist production and distribution. Consciousness of our power will grow, as a result of this mass contact with the ruling forces. There is no question that people must be organized and educated to the benefits of a peoples government before they can successfully move against their class enemy. However, there seems to be some question as to how seriously we should take ourselves and our work of organizing.” (ibid. George Jackson, *Blood in my Eye*, p. 81)

“The peoples consciousness is NOT BEING FED, the potential of the people is not being met by those who have tasked themselves with leading the struggle. The people are ready, the u.s government and its extreme right wing fascism has perfectly set the stage for a social revolution, but the people are never going to organize themselves. They have to be fed the right information and given the right tools to evolve past this stage of agitation that they are in. However, if those who have the potential to educate & organize are themselves (consciously or unconsciously) so neocolonized by these social constructs and class antagonisms that they refuse to make the necessary sacrifices for Our freedom, then they too are a contradiction that opposes the power of the people. This is one of the biggest forms of liberalism that we must combat, how long shall we wade in the shallow waters of this low tide because we know that we’re not suppose to splash or make waves? Continuing to struggle and organize at a level that is allowed or deemed acceptable, safe or “legal” is not revolutionary at all. As Safiya Bukhari pointed out, revolution in its initial stage should be to create a new society/identity. Our cadre and governmental workers do this by transforming the hearts and minds of Our women, men, and children with decolonization programs. These are the basic tenets for any collective or government, things to win over the people and guide them on a path toward liberation. most comrades who have started a formation or took on the task of developing a national united front already know this, the error is that We onboard new members who we meet in the course of “doing the work” on a variation of PP campaigns, defense committees, prison abolition or community based networks, mostly virtual or on a call — and we often mistake our own consciousness or knowledge of the line for others and We assume these individuals understand the mission or vision being pushed. BAs a united front or umbrella, PLM is a network that includes a majority of the leading PP campaigns, defense committees, BPP veterans and prisoner support groups who are active today, with overlapping membership and goals that work in unison to build state wide, regional and national coordinating committees, PLM is a vehicle for decolonization, unification and infrastructure to strengthen the overall movement. In recent months i have had to do a serious assessment and evaluation of the reason we continue to suffer surrounding the issues of coordination, communication & capacity in regard to various sub committees and a lack of commitment to assigned task. I asked myself in frustration: “How can We have this many individuals/orgs from ALL walks of movement life on our monthly calls, yet so many of our short term aims & objectives are not being met? Why are we having to reiterate the same structural needs and organizational determination on each zoom meeting?? As the national Director, i have to take on the self criticism & acknowledge the fact that majority of these comrades were allowed to come on board within the last 2–3 years and take on significant roles and responsibilities. We entrusted or assumed that because they were already apart of “this or that org” or invited by “this or that comrade” that they would effectively carry out said task as it aligned with PLM/SOM/Jericho or The peoples senate. There has been no clear cut policy on orientation, P.E and mandatory retention of PLM’s line or an overall process for cadre development. Again, like anything else in life we only know or do what we have been told or shown in regard to

movement work. If since joining the movement or nation in the last 10–15 years individuals have been allowed to join a collective, having never been properly introduced or educated to the inner connectedness of the PISC to our outside struggle to Free The Land, or developed politically thru a curriculum rooted in dialectical/historical materialism, then we have failed. Coming to the realization that we have to collectively hit the emergency brake and establish a series of P.E/cadre development across the board as it relates to the NAIM, PLM + SOM, i again go to the words of Safiya Bukhari: “Individual and organizational safety and well-being begin with the knowledge of what your about, what the organization is about, your limitations, the organizations limitations, your strengths and the organizations strengths. Knowledge is the key to security. History has shown that the best security depends upon the internal strength of the organization and the internal principles of the people who make up the organization... The question, then, is how do we get to this point? It begins with knowing what you’re about — what you want and what you believe in and how far you will go to obtain it. The reciprocal reality is knowing what the organization is about. If the purpose and mission of the organization is clear, not subject to interpretation, then people joining will not be able to say that they thought the organization was about one thing when they joined, only to find out later that it was about something totally different.” PLM is not solely about the lives of prisoners, nor is it designed to complain about poor food, living conditions or the treatment from guards, naturally these things will be addressed and a platform and resources for captives & our families will be readily available to confront these daily realities. We are not a reactionary social movement like #blacklivesmatter, from my observation & analysis of the past 50 years i see that there was a major disconnect between the inside-out movement, and like the countless individuals/formations within the NAIM, the overall prison movement lacked a clear cohesive program that established infrastructure. We then proceeded to use the blueprint and theory found within FROLINAN (Front for the Liberation of the New Afrikan Nation) to build a concrete/sustainable front. PLM is a primary component to help achieve class struggle for national unity if properly understood and applied. Over a span of 8 years, We have unified new Afrikan, chicano, indigenous & poor working-class euro amerikkans around building tangible bases for agriculture, medical, inter-faith, legal and multimedia initiatives. Captives all across the u.s have responded to PLM’s call to action to help build state-wide chapters in their region, to establish inside-out coordination between prisoners in their state and those with boots on the ground. Based on this method of movement/nation building PLM has been designated to advance the cause of determination, like the peoples senate by distributing the senates explanation and recruitment manual to every prison & state where We have individuals or formations to help build up the 6th national regions that make up The peoples senate.

Through coordination, communications and meeting our capacity as a united front We can galvanize the momentum of all our collective efforts. As a whole, We probably have comrades and allies in nearly every state across the map, but lack a concrete tactic or process to utilize this network to uplift the determination of our mission. The individual comrades, orgs, collectives who accepted the call from PLM to serve as NCC members or field marshalls must have a principled understanding that commitment is key. We may be autonomous moving parts that move freely in our own individual organizational capacities, but it is our endeavor to spearhead and coordinate collectively that make up the body as a whole. Organizational structure and determination, the methods, programs and process We set in place to guide us & carry out the vision cannot be disregarded or abandoned in the middle of committing to the task at hand. Monthly meetings of NCC members and biweekly meetings for each sub committee are routine schedules necessary to ensure that the entire body is aligned and organized around a national agenda. This communication & coordination is the heart & soul of a united front, each and every member has a role to play in its capacity to function properly. Joining a

subcommittee, taking on specific work and failing to follow thru on your commitment is unprogressive and harmful to the entire membership. In closing i would like to apologize on behalf of PLM to the countless captives across the KKKountry who have sent letters or responded to our call to develop study groups or structure in your prison, state, region and received no response or lost contact with a coordinator in chicago or virginia. This is another setback as a result of coordination & capacity issues. **All unanswered mail** sent to our chicago P.O box will be forwarded to outside comrades in the state or region from which the correspondence was mailed from in order to develop inside out coordination in 2026. Texas PLM now has its own P.O box, we look forward to further developing that chapter to advance the work already being done. Maintaining regional P.O boxes are a priority for PLM moving into 2026, however, we are focused on making sure these coordinators are trained and vetted to our political line and have the necessary materials on file or print to distribute. In that time, and with the help of some truly amazing people, I've been able to put together a team of topnotch legal experts who're right now hard at work trying to crack the code that will open the doors to my freedom. Needless to say, this freedom (or "liberty," I should say) isn't free; in fact, it costs \$840 an hour! To help raise additional funds, **my campaign is offering high-quality prints** of paintings I have been working on to those of you who are able to make a contribution.

These paintings were conceived and realized through hard work, focus, and effort, and represent the dedication I've brought to bear in every aspect of my struggle. 2. End the abuse! Free Dr. Aafia Siddiqui! By Tania Siddiqui. "For over two decades, political prisoner Dr. Aafia Siddiqui has been held captive without just cause, in prisons across the world. From 2003 until 2008, she was a ghost prisoner in CIA black sites in Afghanistan, including the notorious Bagram Air Base, where she was routinely beaten and violated.

According to Aafia's attorney, Clive Stafford Smith, she is the only woman who underwent the full U.S. Rendition to Torture program. In 2010, Aafia, an innocent Pakistani citizen, was sentenced to 86 years in U.S. federal prison. Since then, she's been carrying out her virtual life sentence at Federal Medical Center (FMC) Carswell in Fort Worth, Texas, the only federal medical prison for women in the U.S., infamously known as the "Hospital of Horrors." Organized by Sis. Tomiko of Aging People in Prison Human Rights Campaign (APP-HRC) and the Internet radio programs *Africa 500* and *The REvolution Is Black Love*, the event drew attendees from Baltimore, Washington DC, South Carolina, Philadelphia PA, Atlanta GA, New York NY and Los Angeles CA.”


From Atlanta Jericho:

“Chairperson Baba Waziri Mustafaa Taqwaa Waliuddin of the Jericho Movement-Atlanta Chapter spoke about the political prisoners as “the heartbeat of the struggle”. Having always known him as the Imam he became rather than the SNCC revolutionary he had been in his youth, Baba Mustafa noted that Imam Jamil was always “there in real time ... still doing grassroots

work in the community” and not hiding in the church or mosque. Having been raised never to compromise, even as he found himself facing a stint of incarceration of his own, he had learned not to talk to the police, not to romanticize the struggle, not to romanticize revolution and “not to live in a bubble either”; as he embraced the mantle of being a New Afrikan Muslim, he learned to embrace activism and Islam as a “culture of resistance”, he learned that “just because you lick the slave master’s boot, won’t liberate you, won’t stop him from coming and knocking at your door.” Islam showed him that “the first revolution is inside yourself. ... If we don’t liberate ourselves, we can’t liberate nobody. ... We’ve got to be accountable for our actions. ... We can no longer think we are safe from a diabolical system ... that will show you no mercy.” Imam Jamil Al-Amin, as well as all our political prisoners, are “the heartbeat of the struggle, and they need our assistance.” Baba Mustafa challenged us to show up for our communities with the same commitment and enthusiasm that was shown in the recent No Kings Marches. July 4, 2026 will see a mobilization to freedom against ongoing genocide and celebrating 250-plus years of resistance in Atlanta, Georgia...” For full event article see:

While the 1998 Treaty was presented to the people of Ireland as the prerequisite to peace, peace has not indeed been the outcome; and instead the result has been the total surrender of Ireland's constitutional claim to the Six Counties, the return of the hated Stormont seat of puppet British government with its built-in loyalist veto, and the re-strengthening of the illegal partition of Ireland. It is our firm contention that a continued British military presence in Ireland is the root cause of the struggle. John asked him about the impact of the trade embargo on people as a whole and people with HIV/AIDS in particular and about their healthcare system.

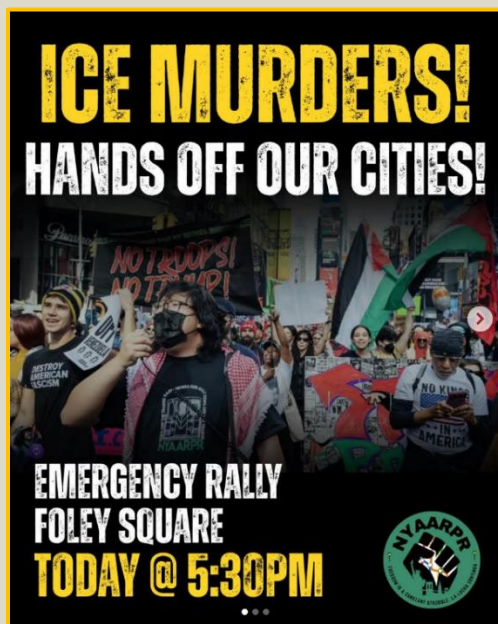

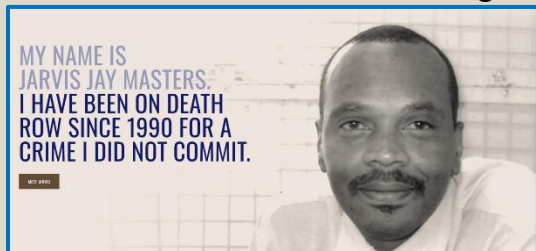


“Former FIFA President Joseph Blatter has now backed comments by Swiss Anti-Corruption Lawyer Mark Pieth to question the safety and security of tourists coming from around the world to watch the games. U.S. officials have chosen to operate outside the bounds of law and basic morality — from supporting Israel’s genocide in Gaza and illegal settlement expansion, to launching a direct military strike on Venezuela that kidnapped President Nicolás Maduro and his wife, to escalating repression against migrants and racialized communities inside the U.S. that has led to murder. These are not isolated policies, but interconnected expressions of an empire that relies on illegal violence abroad and domestically to enforce dominance. Friday January 23rd was one of the largest labor mobilizations in recent U.S. history with 10s of thousands of Minnesotans taking to the street to end the tyrannical violence of ICE and its anti-immigrant operations.

One day later, ICE agents in Minnesota have murdered another person — this time a 37-year-old man. The federal government is systematically violating the most fundamental of human rights: the right to life. While federal officials run cover for their crimes, state and local officials do nothing but stand by, make statements but take no action. We must demand that these democratically elected officials act immediately to defend their constituents and combat all attempts to clean the image of this neo-fascist state.

This includes the World Cup, which should not be used to launder state violence or normalize genocide and international gangsterism. We must take this a step further than hold state and local authorities accountable and demand they use their power to defend the human rights and safety of the people they claim to represent. Organizations and people of conscience must demand that FIFA move the games out of the U.S. and take a stand for people-centered human rights rather than empire, repression, and impunity. “We are grieving and horrified by the murder of Renee Nicole Good, who was killed this week by ICE. Today, we are sending solidarity and care to each of you in this very intense week, and writing with action steps you can take to show up in solidarity.

Renee was likely taking action against what the Trump administration is calling the “largest immigration operation ever,” a deployment of 2,000 ICE agents sent to target Somali and Latino communities. They claim 150 arrests were made on Monday alone. Since Trump’s inauguration, there have been 32 reported deaths in ICE custody.

Renee was killed less than a mile from where George Floyd was murdered by Minneapolis police in 2020. **Once again we see reckless, racist state violence resulting in the loss of life.** We know that militarized state violence – whether abroad in Venezuela or here at home – does not make *any* of

our communities safer. It is deadly to communities of color— and no one who stands in the way of authoritarianism is safe.

This week, a white woman did what those in power fear the most: she broke rank, rejected the racist lies aimed at winning over white people, and instead chose to stand in solidarity with her immigrant neighbors. I know right now many of us are scared, angry, and grieving. And— this is a time for those of us who are white to root in our commitments and continue to take risks and step into action. In the face of intimidation and state repression we must stand resolute, refuse to be intimidated, and recommit to the fight against ICE and white supremacy everywhere. We have been in touch with our chapter and leaders in Minneapolis who are doing just that alongside their community. Over and over again, powerful organizers in the Twin Cities have shown us how to stand up, fight back, and set a vision for a future where multiracial solidarity ensures that all people can live in safety. We must continue to stand alongside our immigrant neighbors and work to defund and dismantle ICE. Here are three ways you can show up this week:

Get into the streets. There are protests popping up across the country— find one near you, stay safe, and join us in our refusal to be intimidated.

First “Antifa” Trial: Take Action for the Prairieland Defendants!



“The NLG has been firmly providing [support and solidarity to the Prairieland Defendants](#), the first activists to be charged as an “antifa terror cell” under this [administration’s orders](#). These folks are facing extreme repression in Northern Texas after an anti-ICE noise

demonstration. The [Prairieland case](#) is deeply alarming for the Dallas-Fort Worth (DFW) community. But it should also concern all of those who oppose fascism given the precedent it could set. Facing the full weight of the U.S. government, some co-defendants [pled guilty](#) to extreme federal charges, with some admitting to verifiably false “antifa” narratives. 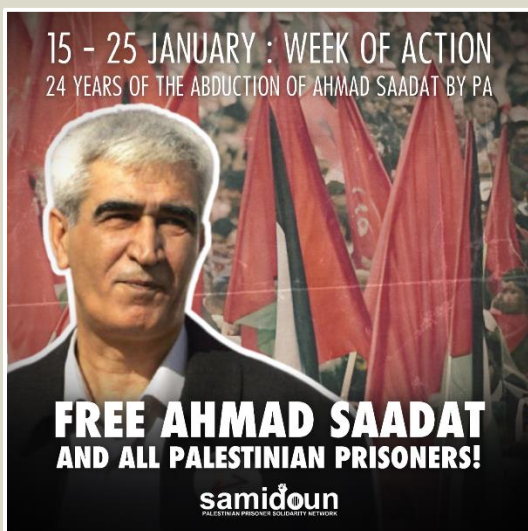

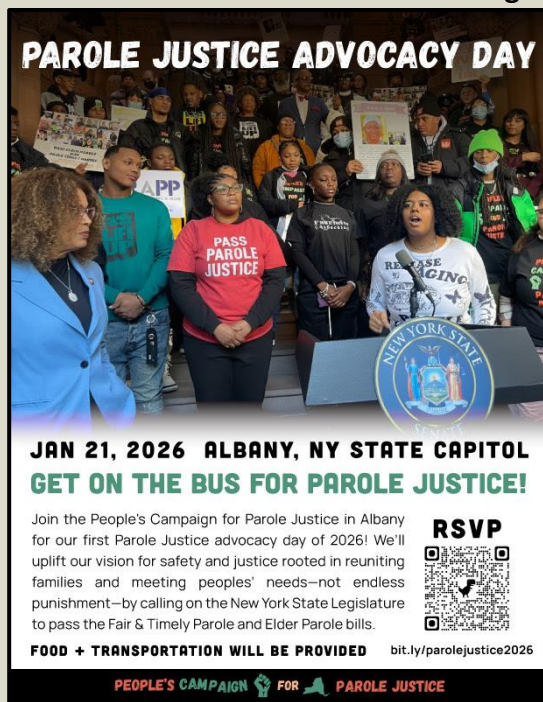

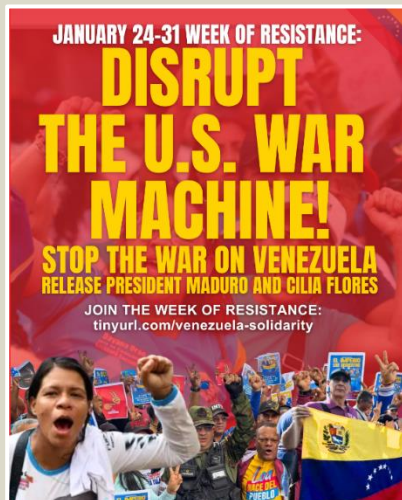

This Week of Resistance is anchored in our uncompromising demands and our foundational commitment to people(s)-centered human rights—rights won from below, through advancement of struggle.

OUR DEMANDS: No War on Venezuela

1. STOP THE WAR ON VENEZUELA! This is not a singular moment but a continuation of the decades-long war on the Bolivarian Revolution. The attack on Venezuela is an attack on the entire Caribbean and Latin America, as well as all working-class people internationally—a brazen attempt to enforce a new Monroe Doctrine.

2. NO TO U.S. WARS FOR REGIME CHANGE! We stand with Venezuela’s communiqué: “The objective of this attack is none other than to seize Venezuela’s strategic resources.” We oppose U.S. aggression against Cuba, Iran, Colombia, Palestine, Haiti, and beyond.

3. FREE PRESIDENT MADURO AND CILIA FLORES! Maduro and Flores are prisoners of war. The “narcoterrorism” charge is a familiar imperialist lie used to criminalize revolutionary leadership.

4. DEFEND VENEZUELA’S SOVEREIGNTY AND RIGHT TO RESIST! Trump claims the U.S. will “run” Venezuela—a psychological warfare tactic that will be rejected by the Venezuelan people, who are already in the streets defending their revolution.

5. END THE U.S. WAR ON MIGRANTS! We must shut down ICE and address the imperialist root causes of forced migration, including the criminalization of migrants and the violation of national sovereignty that displaces people.

6. END THE GENOCIDE IN PALESTINE AND DEFEAT ZIONISM! Zionism is the most vicious expansionist project in the world today, fully armed by the U.S. Its genocide in Gaza, occupation of Palestine, and attacks on Lebanon, Syria, and Yemen are part of a global settler-colonial project. Palestine’s liberation is tied to ours.

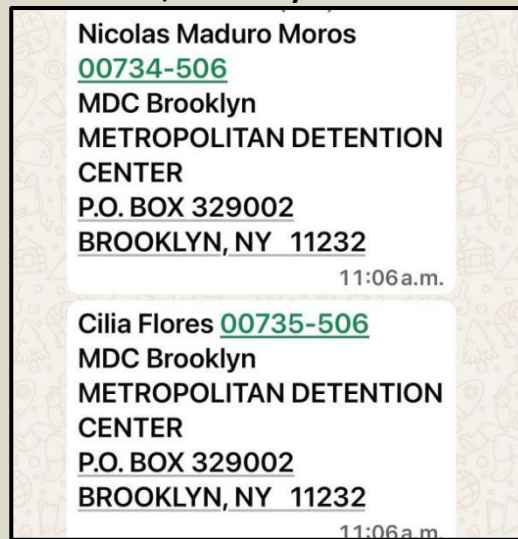
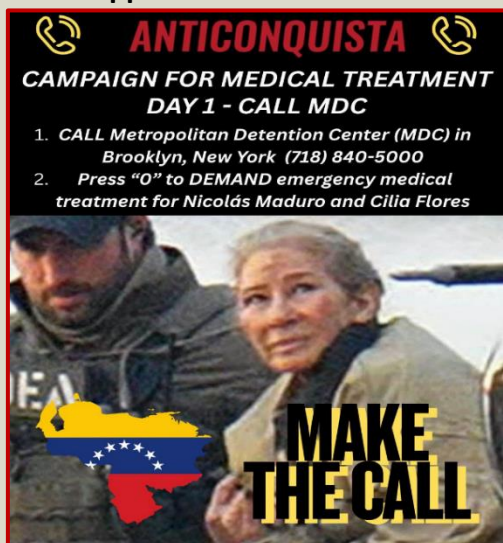

Support Nick Tilsen During Time of Oppression

"As some of you may know, Nick Tilsen, Oglala Lakota, Founder and CEO, NDN Collective, is being brought to trial in Pennington County, South Dakota. On December 15, 2025, the judge who had taken the case under advisement decided to move forward with a trial, which is scheduled to begin on Monday, January 26, 2026. Nick was initially charged with aggravated assault and obstruction of a law enforcement/public officer. But on Monday, January 12, Nick was notified that the Pennington County

Grand Jury added “simple assault” to the list of charges. NDN Collective believes this added charge, which is a felony that is easier to convict with, to be further evidence of political motivation and an abuse of power by the prosecutor’s office.

Support for the charges against Nick to be dropped is clear, with **over 16,500** signatures on a petition to the Pennington County State’s Attorney’s office. Calls to the free people of the world to mobilize on the Int’l Day of Solidarity with Palestinian Prisoners Jan 24



“The Global Campaign to Save Prisoners and the Red Ribbons Campaign launched a call to all free people around the world to mobilize and actively participate in the International Day of Solidarity with Palestinian prisoners. They called for taking to the streets across the world on January 31, so that everyone may be one voice for the sake of Palestinian prisoners. They stressed the necessity of standing with the prisoners in the Israeli prisons, standing up to injustice, expressing

continued support for them, and demanding their freedom. This call comes after a global media campaign aimed at shedding light on the suffering of the prisoners, reshaping international awareness of the Palestinian cause, and breaking decades of falsification and media misinformation. The campaign affirmed that the solidarity movement has proven that popular will is capable of making a real difference, and that every individual can be part of the battle of awareness and dignity through multiple forms of action and civil resistance, from sit-ins and protests to boycott and advocacy campaigns and breaking the “Zionist narrative”.

It also emphasized the importance of reorienting the compass of solidarity and highlighting the issue of Palestinian prisoners in the Israeli prisons, as one of the most urgent and humanitarian causes. It explained that the prisoners face harsh and inhumane conditions, manifested in the most heinous violations, including torture, solitary confinement, deprivation of medical treatment and visits, administrative detention, and the detention of women and children under degrading conditions that violate all international laws and conventions.

The campaign will continue for six months, aiming to unify legal, humanitarian, and media efforts at the Arab and international levels to expose the systematic crimes committed against the prisoners, to apply pressure to improve their conditions of detention, to end policies of isolation and torture, to demand the immediate release of women and children, and to safeguard the human dignity of prisoners as an inherent right that does not lapse with time.

It stated that this campaign is not a fleeting act of solidarity, but rather a moral and humanitarian duty, and a global message affirming that the suffering of the prisoners is an extension of the suffering of an entire people struggling for freedom and justice. “Therefore, we call upon all human rights institutions, media bodies, civil society organizations, influencers, and free people of the world to actively engage in this campaign, to ensure that the issue of the prisoners remains present in global consciousness, until they attain their full and undiminished freedom,” the campaigners said.”

Detroit attorneys were among the **founding members** of the NLG in 1937. Two of these attorneys, Maurice Sugar and Ernest Goodman, began the **Sugar Law Center for Economic & Social Justice**, a Detroit law firm, that was active in defending workers and their unions, such as the United Auto Workers, and representing Black people who were being harassed by the police. With civil rights leaders and activists George Crockett, Jr., Bob Millender, and Claudia Morcom, Ernest went on to found Goodman, Eden, Crockett, Millender, and Bedrosian, the first racially integrated law firm in the country. 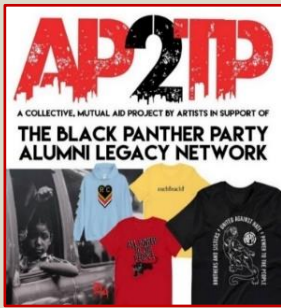

Dear Friend and Fellow Freedom Fighter,

The Spirit of Mandela Coalition, following up on the October 2021 International Tribunal verdict finding the US Guilty of Genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous people (see full verdict [HERE](#)), is calling for the building of a new mass grassroots formation: The Peoples' Senate. The people need to govern and represent themselves in combating genocide and addressing their right to a just and humane existence. Our vision is for the Peoples' Senate, organized directly by our oppressed communities, to grow into a body which will serve that purpose.

Today our communities face the most egregious violations of our human rights since the civil rights and Black power movements of the 1960s and '70s. Conditions we are living under include random mass shootings, right-wing vigilante attacks, police violence and murder, environmental racism, the reassertion of "states rights" (the "right" of states to ignore basic human rights), and healthcare racism. The US government dangerously scapegoats immigrants; causes destabilization, extreme violence, bombing, and killing of Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people all over the globe – and spends billions of dollars to do it; and keeps hundreds of thousands of people living in homelessness and poverty in the US. Our communities are facing targeted attacks against voting rights, workers' rights, women's rights, and Indigenous Peoples' rights as right-wing elected officials and appointed judges roll back decades of hard-won battles for justice. While out-voting right-wing

candidates during elections is important, voting alone will not be enough. We must organize to put more pressure on the system for major change.

The US Congress and Senate are representatives of the rich and powerful. They refuse to address the necessity for universal healthcare or a sound nationwide infrastructure providing access to clean water and other necessities. Corporations ignore and violate the needs of the planet while evading their fair share of taxes. US prisons are filled with Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people, many incarcerated for crimes they did not commit and/or serving sentences that far outweigh whatever criminal acts they may have committed. The oppressed national communities of Black, Brown, and Indigenous peoples all have political prisoners and prisoners of war incarcerated since the 1960s until today, who have fought for our liberation and are being held in prison unjustly or only released when near death. We want them all freed now!

Building our own Peoples' Senate will enable us to organize locally from a position of strength and connect local activists with others, in other parts of the country, who may be pursuing similar goals while electing "Senators" who are mandated to represent our interests and demands. A Peoples' Senate can fight for changes that protect and ensure our right to vote, our right to control our own bodies, our right to live free from discrimination as LGBTQ+ people, our rights to living wages and safe working conditions, our rights to sovereignty and dignity, and our rights to live free from state violence and abuse.
