International Women's Day: The Inspiring Resistance of Palestinian Women

"On 8 March, the reality of Palestinian women cannot be separated from their tireless resistance to colonial violence and ongoing genocide — which demolishes their homes, threatens their land and

throws them in prison cells. Women also carry most of the burden of caring for a grieving community.

For nearly a hundred years, Palestinian women have been at the heart of the struggle against Israel's settler-colonial and apartheid regime in various fields, making them direct targets. Israel's leaders have always considered Palestinian women a "demographic threat" to its colonial project. For example, former Israeli Minister Ayelet Shaked directly [called](#) for the targeting and killing of Palestinian women, especially the mothers of martyrs, describing them as "raising little snakes." For two years of genocide, Israel [killed](#) on average seven women every two hours, including two mothers. The number of Palestinian women and girls [killed](#) by Israel in Gaza is stated to be over 28,000 with over 78,000 women and girls injured.

As the UN Independent International Commission of Inquiry [concluded](#) in its shocking report of March 2025, Israel's systematic destruction of reproductive and sexuality healthcare facilities and denial of basic humanitarian needs have caused "physical and mental harm and suffering to [Palestinian] women and girls that will have irreversible long-term effects on the mental health and the physical reproductive and fertility prospects of the Palestinians in Gaza as a group." These acts, the Commission said, "amount to crimes against humanity and deliberately inflicting conditions of life calculated to bring about the physical destruction of Palestinians as a group, one of the categories of genocidal acts in the Rome Statute and the Genocide Convention."

Every day, dozens of Palestinian women are [forced](#) to give birth under shelling and the sound of gunfire, without any medical care during or after childbirth. Israel's occupation has forced thousands of pregnant women to constantly move under the immediate threat of death, many of whom have [miscarried](#) as a result of these conditions. The suffering of hundreds of thousands of Palestinian women has been compounded by direct injuries from the bombing. They are also under risk of contracting multiple diseases as a result of genocidal Israel preventing the delivery of aid containing essential health supplies to the Gaza Strip. Even before the beginning of Israel's genocide, the prolonged criminal siege imposed by Israel for more than 17 years exacerbated the difficult living conditions for Palestinian women in Gaza.

As apartheid Israel escalates ethnic cleansing in the West Bank, including occupied Jerusalem — Palestinian women stand at the heart of communities facing and resisting continued attacks by Israeli occupation forces and settlers, particularly in areas where land is essential for survival.

In Israeli prisons, Israel imposes an even more complex reality on female Palestinian prisoners in general. Apartheid Israel arrests dozens of women from the West Bank, including Jerusalem, and an unknown number from Gaza. These women are subjected to the most heinous forms of assault and psychological, physical, and sexual torture. Israel not only subjects them to daily oppression and violations, depriving them of the most basic human rights and daily health needs, but also forces them to face pain without any healthcare. In just one instance, the Israeli authorities forced prisoner [Tahani Abu Samhan](#) to give birth without any medical support, for her or her newborn.

Israel's violence does not affect Palestinian women alone; its impact extends to women across West Asia and North Africa. As Israel's wars of aggression against the peoples of the region expand from Lebanon to Syria and from Yemen to Iran, women across the region confront the human cost of repeated wars and displacement, while sustaining the struggle for liberation and dignity..." **For Full Statement see:** <https://bdsmovement.net/news/IWD-2026>

Revolutionary Greetings to Jericho's Newest Political Prisoner Alexander Contompasis

“Alexander Stokes Contompasis is a Jewish American independent journalist and activist who is currently serving a draconian 20 year sentence for defending himself and three others against an attack by Proud Boys and Oath Keepers on January 6, 2021 in Albany, New York.

Alex Stokes Contompasis is a journalist and artist from Albany, New York. Alex’s work documenting social unrest began in 2014. He was arrested in 2017 in Washington DC during the Disrupt J20 inaugural protests and co-represented over 200 counter-protestors and independent journalists who were rounded up and falsely charged. He was in Charlottesville, VA during the summer protests in 2017. He routinely attended and recorded Black Lives Matter protests in Albany in 2020. He also regularly revealed local white supremacist groups and members. Prior to 2021, he was taking classes to prepare to become an Emergency Medical Technician.

On January 6, 2021, protestors gathered outside the New York State Capitol in Albany, NY in support of the Stop the Steal rally in Washington DC. A handful of counter protesters spoke out against them and a melee broke out after a Proud Boy tased a Black man in the neck. Alex was watching from the sidelines and ran to help others. Police did not intervene until the violence had ended and ultimately arrested three Black activists. Alex was charged with several violent felonies. The Proud Boys who engaged in the violence were not arrested at the scene.

Alex’s family and friends maintain that he was railroaded by the system. He was a journalist under a court-ordered gag-order for over a year. His previous work and experience with dangerous hate groups were inadmissible for his defense, but the prosecution picked apart his social media accounts and portrayed his actions as premeditated. He was found guilty on all charges and sentenced to 20 years in prison, despite the fact that no one died and neither of the so-called “victims” received life-altering injuries. One even began a job as an EMT just 6 weeks later.

A man with no previous criminal history, with lifelong ties to the community, was issued a sentence far more severe than most who commit reckless and premeditated acts of violence. His sentence is longer than those who assaulted police officers at the US Capitol on January 6, 2021 and those who organized the insurrection itself.

Alex is an amateur journalist. Beginning in 2014, he hosted a local public access channel based in Albany called News World: Albany Banana Corps. He and others commented on news stories and filmed demonstrations against police brutality, environmental issues, and other local concerns, as well

as musical performances and multiple public events and meetings. He interviewed local activists and politicians, law enforcement officers, and concerned citizens. He traveled to other notable areas of unrest, including Baltimore Maryland, Washington DC, and Charlottesville Virginia. In 1968, Safiya Bukhari witnessed an NYPD officer harassing a Black Panther for selling the organization's newspaper on a Harlem street corner. The young pre-med student felt compelled to intervene in defense of the Panther's First Amendment right; she ended up handcuffed and thrown into the back of a police car.

The War Before traces Bukhari's lifelong commitment as an advocate for the rights of the oppressed. Following her journey from middle-class student to Black Panther to political prisoner, these writings provide an intimate view of a woman wrestling with the issues of her time—the troubled legacy of the Panthers, misogyny in the movement, her decision to convert to Islam, the incarceration of outspoken radicals, and the families left behind. Her account unfolds with immediacy and passion, showing how the struggles of social justice movements have paved the way for the progress of today.

**MESSAGE OF CONDOLENCES ON THE TRANSITION OF OUR REVOLUTIONARY SISTA,
COMRADE & FRIEND SAFIYA BUKHARI, HAVANA CUBA -August 29, 2003**

It is with much sadness that i say my last goodbye to Safiya Bukhari. She was my sister, my comrade and my friend. We met nearly thirty-five years ago, when we were both members of the Black Panther Party in Harlem. Even then, i was impressed by her sincerity, her commitment and her burning energy. She was a descendant of slaves and she inherited the legacy of neo-slavery. She believed that struggle was the only way that African people in America could rid ourselves of oppression.

As a Black woman struggling in America she experienced the most vicious forms of racism, sexism, cruelty and indifference. As a political activist she was targeted, persecuted, hounded and harassed. Because of her political activities she became a political prisoner and spent many years in prison. But she continued to believe in freedom, and she continued to fight for it. In spite of her personal suffering, in spite of chronic, life-threatening illnesses, she continued to struggle.

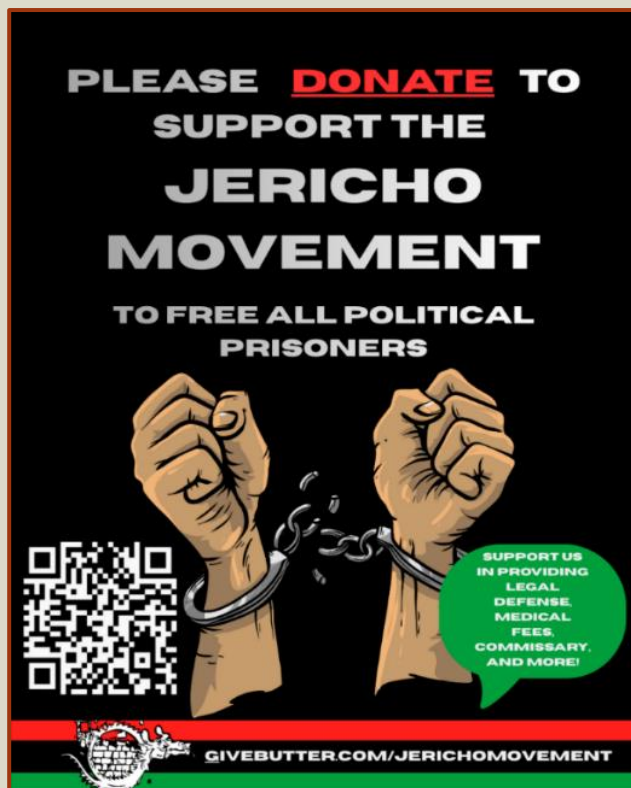
She gave the best that she had to give to our people. She devoted her life, her love and her best energies to fighting for the liberation of oppressed people. She struggled selflessly, she could be trusted, she was consistent, and she could always be counted to do what needed to be done.

She was a soldier, a warrior-woman who did everything she could to free her people and to free political prisoners. Her absence will be felt. She will be sincerely missed.

I have faith that the Ancestors will welcome her, cherish her, and treat her with more love and more kindness that she ever received here on this earth.

I pray that her sisters and brothers, who continue to walk on this planet, will honor her memory by continuing her work, by continuing her struggle, and refusing to quit until all oppressed people and all Political Prisoners are free." **Assata Shakur.** Source: Email.



**International Al-Quds Day 2026: A call to action for Al-Quds,
Palestine, Lebanon, Iran, and humanity March 13-15**



“This year, in 2026, the International Day of Al-Quds, the international day of action held on the third Friday of Ramadan for the Palestinian cause and the liberation of Jerusalem from Zionism and imperialism, takes on an extremely urgent and historic significance. Marked since 1979, when it was first declared by Imam Ruhollah Khomeini, this year’s commemoration arrives amid one of the most dangerous escalations faced by the peoples of the region. As the world marks the 47th International Al-Quds Day, the struggle for the liberation of Palestine and Jerusalem stands at the center of a regional and global confrontation with Zionism and imperialism. Samidoun Palestinian Prisoner Solidarity Network reiterates our urgent call to action for Al-Quds Day, Friday, March 13, and throughout the weekend, March 14-15, for actions, mass mobilization and protest, direct actions and confronting the Zionist and imperialist war machine everywhere.

As the Masar Badil, the Palestinian Alternative Revolutionary Path Movement and the Popular Democratic Party in Lebanon appealed: “Declare International Quds Day, Friday, March 13, a global day against war and aggression, and a day of solidarity and unity for Palestine, Iran, and Lebanon, affirming the peoples’ right to liberation, sovereignty, and self-determination.”

History of the Kidnapping of Dr. Reiner Fuellmich

Prairieland defendants

“On Friday, March 20th, nine of the Prairieland Defendants were convicted of federal felony charges for the “crime” of protesting the white supremacist brutality of ICE. Daniel Sanchez Estrada was convicted

of “corruptly concealing documents” for moving a box of zines from his parents’ house to his own house, and Benjamin Song, Savanna Batten, Zachary Evetts, Meagan Morris, Maricela Rueda, Autumn Hill, Elizabeth Soto, and Ines Soto were convicted of “terrorism” charges for attending a noise demonstration outside the Prairieland ICE Detention Center in Alvarado, Texas. Still, the defendants continue to fight these unjust charges, facing a long road ahead of appeals and additional state charges. Dario Sanchez, another one of the defendants, has his state trial on April 20th. He faces charges of “hindering prosecution of terrorism” and “fabricating physical evidence” for removing someone from a signal group. The outcome of his trial could have far reaching consequences for us all. 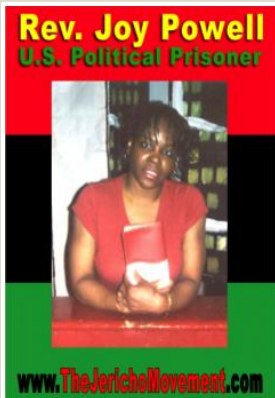

“Abdul developed the George Jackson University, that at one time had over a million students. “The state” shut it down, of course and he had to rebuild, which he did. A powerful statement of his undaunted spirit and fierce resistance to injustice and illegitimate authority, while enduring the state’s torture program of forcing New Afrikans into security housing units (SHUs), solitary confinement, designed to break their revolutionary mind and spirit.

Captured at 16-years-old, Abdul spent the next 44+ years under severely oppressive and repressive conditions, studying, analyzing, developing theories; all which he put into practice to develop his mind, body and spirit and become an educator, an author of multiple educational books and a highly conscious New Afrikan man.

Despite expected violence, human rights violations and denial of his freedom by the state and CDCr, he, along with his New Afrikan Brothas, practiced Black August year after year; participated in the Historic California Hunger Strikes, to which they committed to their death, if necessary. Abdul engaged in the class action lawsuit, *Ashker v Brown*, to end indefinite solitary confinement, demonstrating the ability and need to build unity with outside orgs, activists, etc. to build power and win, and he was the mastermind behind the original concept of the Agreement to End Hostilities – the most important document of the past 50 years. So powerful, CDCr undermined its implementation into California’s prisons, but it couldn’t be stopped – wherever it was, violence decreased significantly.

Abdul Olugbala Shakur was told the only way to escape the torture of the SHU was to “parole, snitch or die.” He stood firm against all those dehumanizing options to maintain his humanity, follow in the footsteps of his Ancestors and continue to serve the People.”

He continues to suffer elder abuse and medical neglect in the prison system. “At 1am on March 6, Cal Poly Tech Humboldt university police arrested Rick Toledo from Students for a Democratic Society in the middle of the night for a sit-in and one-day building occupation for Palestine done on Feb 27, 2026. He, along with two other students, have been suspended by the university, with a conduct hearing set to occur soon, and he has been fired from his university teaching position. Aside from protesting for divestment from Israel, students were also sitting in to demand a sanctuary campus from ICE. The DA's office claims they will hold him until Tuesday. We in the CSFR say: Free Rick Toledo! Don't charge him, and release him now!

We in the Committee to Stop FBI Repression call on all supporters of free speech and the right to assembly to call the Humboldt County District Attorney Stacy Eads' office and to demand that Rick Toledo is released at once. He did nothing wrong in attending a student sit-in, and committed no crime. The student sit-in occurred because the university administration did not want to concede to their demands for divestment and for sanctuary.

Call to action against the “Prisoners’ Execution Law”
in occupied Palestine: Globalize the Intifada! March 30



“On Monday, 30 March, 2026 – the 50th Palestinian Land Day – the Zionist Knesset adopted in its third and final reading, the “execution law” targeting Palestinian prisoners by a vote of 62 and 48, including that of war criminal Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. Notorious fascist Itamar Ben-Gvir celebrated its passage by uncorking a bottle of champagne on the floor of the Knesset for a bloodthirsty celebration, cheering openly at the attempted legitimization of the genocide of Palestinians behind occupation bars.

There are over 9,500 Palestinian prisoners – alongside Lebanese and Arab prisoners – held in the occupation’s dungeons, already subjected to an institutionalized regime of torture, physical and sexual assault and abuse, medical neglect and mistreatment, whose lives are at risk. Since the launch of Al-Aqsa Flood and the over 2.5 years of genocide in Gaza, over a hundred Palestinian prisoners have already been martyred behind bars, not counting the thousands of Palestinians in Gaza whose bodies were returned in mass graves and bags, shot dead by the occupation, their bodies and organs opened in many cases, with their hands shackled or zip-tied behind their backs.

We must not allow this moment to pass alongside the numerous crimes of the occupation regime. Samidoun Palestinian Prisoner Solidarity Network joins our voices with those of the Palestinian resistance movements and prisoners’ organizations to raise our shouts of outrage and to emphasize: This is the time to globalize the intifada, to take the streets in mass mobilization and direct action, to rise up for the prisoners, who sacrifice their freedom and their lives for the liberation of Palestine and the defense of humanity. It is our responsibility to organize and act to save the lives of the prisoners and free them from the horrors of captivity with an uprising for the prisoners, not only in Palestine but everywhere around the world.

The Zionist entity – and its imperialist and colonialist sponsors, allies and forebears – have always treated incarceration and assassination as parallel tools of oppression directed against the organizing, resistance and struggle of the Palestinian people for liberation. This law seeks to impose a veneer of “legitimacy” of what is nothing more than the ongoing practice of colonialists assassinating the leaders of liberation movements, in an attempt to strangle the Palestinian people and their will to resist with the hangman’s noose specified in the text of the law. Just as the repeated assassinations of revolutionary and resistance leaders over the decades have failed to quell the resistance in Palestine,

Lebanon and throughout the region, so too will this bloody oppression smash up against the rocks of the people's dedication to liberate their land.

The blatant racism and fascism of the Zionist regime is written explicitly into the text of the law. It applies to Palestinians, mostly from the West Bank, tried in military courts by the occupation army, but also to Palestinians from Jerusalem, 1948 occupied Palestine and Gaza tried in so-called "civil courts," for whom death or life sentence may be chosen. These executions specifically target only Palestinians engaged in resistance; not only is settler violence ignored and rewarded in practice, it is legally exempt from the execution law. Of course, unlike the cruel settler violence directed daily against Palestinians remaining on their land, Palestinian revolutionary armed struggle is not only morally just and a natural response of a people denied their homes, lands and homeland – it is entirely legally justified, as peoples have a well-defined and recognized right under international law to resist foreign occupation and colonial domination by all means, including and especially armed struggle.

Under the law, the executions must be carried out by hanging, as an explicit form of legalized, racist lynching; during his campaign for the bill, Ben-Gvir adorned his suit with a pin of a hangman's noose as an open threat on the lives of Palestinians. In addition, these assassination executions are to be carried out within 90 days of sentencing. The law also purports to prohibit the most effective mechanism of liberating Palestinian prisoners – that is, prisoner exchanges with the Resistance. This is an attempt to suppress the plans and actions of resistance forces to achieve a prisoner exchange by excluding those with the most severe sentences; however, in reality, prisoner exchanges are not a matter of law and legal calculation, but are achieved solely through the imposition of force and power by the oppressed against the occupier and oppressor.

Of course, the slaughter of Palestinian prisoners is not a new goal of the occupation regime. On a daily basis, occupation forces carry out arrest/assassination raids in which they deliberately target Palestinians for assassination under the pretext of attempted arrest, and regularly deny treatment to injured Palestinians as they are martyred under arrest. Assassination has become part and parcel of the siege on Gaza, with police officers and land defenders targeted on a near-daily basis by occupation bombs and drones. Palestinians inside the occupation jails are subjected to escalated and institutional medical neglect, a crisis that has become only more severe since 7 October 2023.

The law, much like "administrative detention," under which over 3,600 Palestinians are jailed without charge or trial, recalls the British execution policy against Palestinians in resistance. Indeed, [Fouad Hijazi, Mohammad Jamjoum, and Ataa al-Zeer](#), three Palestinian revolutionary prisoners executed by the British in 1930, have become icons of the prisoners' movement, while the song in their honor, "From Akka Prison," has remained one of its anthems for nearly a century..." 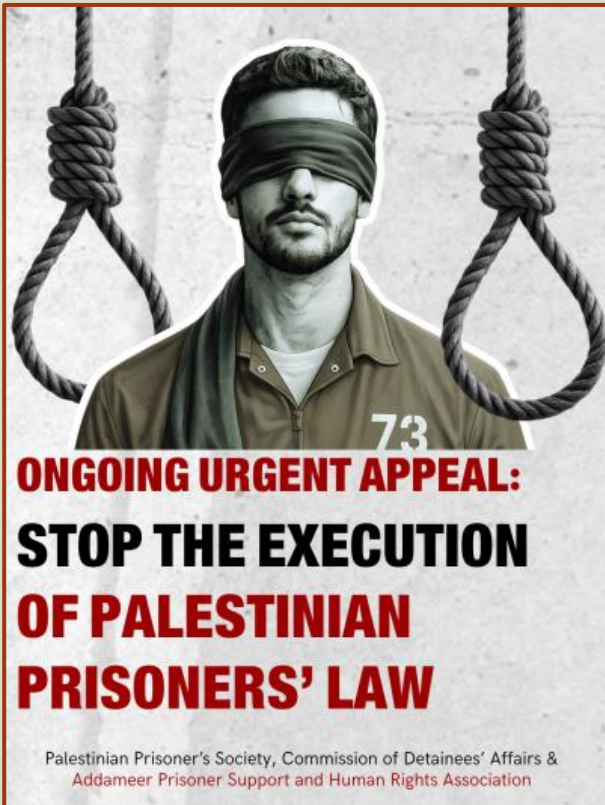

ONGOING URGENT APPEAL: STOP THE EXECUTION OF PALESTINIAN PRISONERS' LAW



“Palestinian Prisoner’s Society, Commission of Detainees’ Affairs & Addameer Prisoner Support and Human Rights Association March 29, 2026

“Ramallah, occupied Palestine – On Monday, March 30, the Israeli occupation’s proposed “Prisoners’ Execution Law” is expected to be brought forward for its second and third readings in the Knesset, with a high likelihood of passage—despite sustained global appeals and unequivocal warnings from international human rights institutions condemning its adoption. If enacted, this bill will mark a historic escalation—a new phase of openly sanctioned, politically motivated executions of Palestinian prisoners. It codifies state-sanctioned political murder and turns prisons into legalized killing grounds and central arenas of torture. Make no mistake: its passage would make it an extension of a multi-pronged system of genocide that has targeted Palestinian existence for decades—rendering the occupation’s prisons and detention camps a direct extension of genocidal policies and a central theater for their execution.

The law constitutes a profound violation of fundamental human rights and exposes decades of international complicity, lack of will, failure, and refusal to hold the settler-colony of “Israel” accountable. After years of calculated advancement by the regime—now reaching its brutal apex amid the genocide—this bill has become inseparable from the government’s political survival. The gallows are no longer symbolic; they are being institutionalized as a central tool of oppression and settler-colonial violence.

Under the most “extreme” and openly ideological government in the settler-colony’s history, the drive to pass this law has accelerated with alarming force. Led by minister Itamar Ben-Gvir and backed by a dominant right-wing bloc in the Knesset, the government has staked its very survival on its passage, with full backing from Benjamin Netanyahu—elevating the execution of prisoners into an explicit political doctrine and a defining pillar of the regime.

For decades, occupation authorities have practiced extrajudicial killing as a sustained policy—now risen to unprecedented levels. This includes targeted assassinations, a “shoot-to-kill” policy and sniper fire. Alongside these overt acts, a quieter but equally lethal system of both slow and direct killings operates within prisons, camps, and interrogation centers, where neglect, abuse, and torture systematically claim lives. Since the start of the genocide alone, more than 100 prisoners have been killed behind bars—marking the deadliest period in the history of the Palestinian prisoners’ movement.

Based on information gathered by our organizations and others, here is an initial set of facts surrounding the execution of Palestinian prisoners bill:

- The law will not be applied retroactively; it will only take effect after its implementation.
- It will include two separate court systems: Military courts in the 1967-occupied Palestinian territories and civilian courts in the 1948-occupied Palestinian territories (“Israel”).

- In “Israeli” military courts, Palestinian prisoners “convicted” of carrying out armed operations resulting in the death of an “Israeli” would face a mandatory death sentence, unless the court identifies exceptional circumstances warranting commutation to life imprisonment.
 - Prisoners would retain the right to appeal; however, rulings would be decided by a simple majority rather than unanimity, and judges would not be required to hold senior military rank.
- In “Israeli” civil courts, however, a prisoner “convicted” carrying out armed operations resulting in the death of an “Israeli” faces a sentence of either life imprisonment or death; this legal hierarchy effectively transforms the death penalty into a primary and fundamental punishment against Palestinians.
- Although this law will not apply to prisoners detained in connection with October 7, 2023 whom the occupation classifies as “elite,” a Knesset committee has approved a separate bill titled the “Law on the Trial of Participants in the October 7 Events.” This bill establishes a special military tribunal that is likewise empowered to impose the death penalty, alongside other measures.

This push to formalize the execution of Palestinian prisoners is not incidental—it is the logical continuation and legal codification of ongoing, unchecked genocidal mass violence and erasure. The law is one among a wide arsenal of measures designed to entrench domination, crush Palestinian society, and normalize the systematic murder of Palestinians. The occupation’s prisons and detention camps are not merely sites of imprisonment—they are central infrastructures of state murder and violence. Stop the execution of Palestinian political prisoners’ law before it is too late.” Source: Email.

“Leqaa Kordia has been jailed for nearly a year, despite a judge twice ordering her release, simply for protesting the genocide that took the lives of nearly 200 of her relatives. A 33-year-old Palestinian woman who has lived in the U.S. for

nearly a decade, Leqaa was among hundreds arrested at a Columbia University protest in 2024 calling for a ceasefire in Gaza. Charges were quickly dropped, but nearly a year later, the Department of Homeland Security targeted Leqaa, spying on her and interrogating her friends and family. Leqaa was detained in March 2025, and she’s been held in a Texas immigration facility ever since.

Leqaa’s plight has not received the attention it deserves, but we are working to change that.

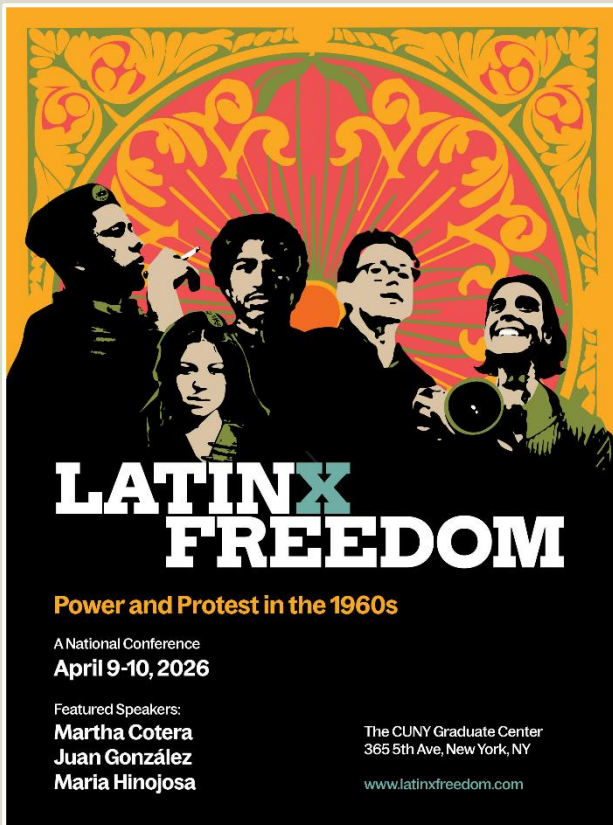
Resistance and Resilience in the West Bank April 9

You may have heard about our comrades in the **Detroit-Michigan NLG** chapter who gave us this **evergreen reminder about what to say** when interacting with police. Detroit attorneys were among the **founding members** of the NLG in 1937. Two of these attorneys, Maurice Sugar and Ernest Goodman, began the **Sugar Law Center for Economic & Social Justice**, a Detroit law firm, that was active in defending workers and their unions, such as the United Auto Workers, and representing Black people who were being harassed by the police. With civil rights leaders and activists George Crockett, Jr., Bob Millender, and Claudia Morcom, Ernest went on to found Goodman, Eden, Crockett, Millender, and Bedrosian, the first racially integrated law firm in the country. 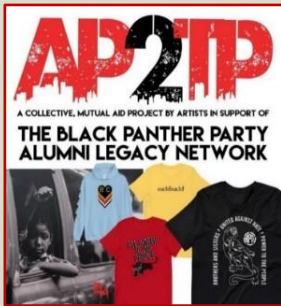

of five accounts of genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous people??

Dear Friend and Fellow Freedom Fighter,

The Spirit of Mandela Coalition, following up on the October 2021 International Tribunal verdict finding the US Guilty of Genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous people (see full verdict [HERE](#)),

is calling for the building of a new mass grassroots formation: The Peoples' Senate. The people need to govern and represent themselves in combating genocide and addressing their right to a just and humane existence. Our vision is for the Peoples' Senate, organized directly by our oppressed communities, to grow into a body which will serve that purpose.

Today our communities face the most egregious violations of our human rights since the civil rights and Black power movements of the 1960s and '70s. Conditions we are living under include random mass shootings, right-wing vigilante attacks, police violence and murder, environmental racism, the reassertion of "states rights" (the "right" of states to ignore basic human rights), and healthcare racism. The US government dangerously scapegoats immigrants; causes destabilization, extreme violence, bombing, and killing of Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people all over the globe – and spends billions of dollars to do it; and keeps hundreds of thousands of people living in homelessness and poverty in the US. Our communities are facing targeted attacks against voting rights, workers' rights, women's rights, and Indigenous Peoples' rights as right-wing elected officials and appointed judges roll back decades of hard-won battles for justice. While out-voting right-wing candidates during elections is important, voting alone will not be enough. We must organize to put more pressure on the system for major change.

The US Congress and Senate are representatives of the rich and powerful. They refuse to address the necessity for universal healthcare or a sound nationwide infrastructure providing access to clean water and other necessities. Corporations ignore and violate the needs of the planet while evading their fair share of taxes. US prisons are filled with Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people, many incarcerated for crimes they did not commit and/or serving sentences that far outweigh whatever criminal acts they may have committed. The oppressed national communities of Black, Brown, and Indigenous peoples all have political prisoners and prisoners of war incarcerated since the 1960s until today, who have fought for our liberation and are being held in prison unjustly or only released when near death. We want them all freed now!

Building our own Peoples' Senate will enable us to organize locally from a position of strength and connect local activists with others, in other parts of the country, who may be pursuing similar goals while electing "Senators" who are mandated to represent our interests and demands. A Peoples' Senate can fight for changes that protect and ensure our right to vote, our right to control our own bodies, our right to live free from discrimination as LGBTQ+ people, our rights to living wages and safe working conditions, our rights to sovereignty and dignity, and our rights to live free from state violence and abuse.
